

# **GVR COMPUTER CLUB CONSTITUTION**

## **ARTICLE I: NAME**

The Organization shall be called "GVR Computer Club"

## **ARTICLE II: PURPOSE**

To provide assistance, exchange of information and social contacts to those members of Green Valley Recreation, Inc. who share an interest in personal computers.

## **ARTICLE III: INDEBTEDNESS**

The maximum indebtedness of the Organization shall not exceed the value of cash assets of the Organization.

## **ARTICLE IV: LIABILITY OF MEMBERS**

Private property of members of the Organization shall forever be exempt from all corporate liabilities, and no member shall be individually liable for any liability of the Corporation.

## **ARTICLE V: ORGANIZED NOT FOR PROFIT**

The Organization is not organized for pecuniary profit as its object, and the members thereof have no individual interest in any property, assets or profits of the Organization.

## **ARTICLE VI: OPERATION**

The GVR Computer Club, as a "GVR Club" under Green Valley Recreation, Inc. The Organization shall operate within the GVR Club Bylaws and GVR Club Organization Rules and Regulations.

## **ARTICLE VII: AMENDMENTS OF ARTICLES OF THE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS**

The Constitution and Bylaws may be amended by:

FIRST: A majority vote of the Board of Directors, and

SECOND: Approval of the Green Valley Recreation, Inc., and

THIRD: By a two-thirds vote of all members present at a regular membership meeting or a special membership meeting.

No amendment shall be in conflict with the Green Valley Recreation, Inc. "Guide Lines" and policies.

## **ARTICLE VIII: DISPOSITION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION OF THE ORGANIZATION**

The Organization will comply with Green Valley Recreation, Inc. "Steps in filing for GVR Club Status."
