

AUGUST SUMMER SCHOOL CONTENT/TIMETABLE OVERVIEW



This document is designed to give parents a flavour of how the summer school will be structured and the content that will be covered. All courses are designed and taught by serving school leaders. Lessons will take place at 09:15–15:30 (pick up and drop off any time between 08:30–17:15).

FAQs

Who will teach the children?

The children will be grouped in small year group classes. All will be taught be senior school leaders (Deputy Headteachers) and serving Year 5 and 6 teachers.

Will the children need to bring their own lunch? Yes. We will provide healthy snacks and drinks throughout the day.

How much does it cost?

Week one is 5 days from 19th—23rd August and costs £395. Week two is four days (the Monday is a Bank Holiday) and costs £325. Both weeks are on offer for £695.

Can I pay in stages?

Yes. We ask for a non-refundable £50 deposit and then can take staggered payments in the lead up to the course.

What time does the course start and finish?

Doors will open at 08:30 and we ask children to be picked up by 17:15. Parents can, of course, pick up and drop off within these hours. Lessons will begin at 09:15 and finish at 15:30.
