We are excited for you and your child to start this year-long journey through the Bible with us! One of our focuses for the year as a church is Biblical literacy, and that includes Children's Ministry. We hope that you enjoy exploring each book of the Bible with these weekly lessons and activities available online. The lesson packet includes:

- **Large Group Lesson** - Children's mini-sermon/lesson to read with your child
- **Small Group Discussion** - questions to discuss with your child
- **Craft activity or coloring page**
- **Suggested reading** - additional reading that you and your child can complete together during the week
