Dear Eighth Grade Student:

The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, Sons and Daughters of Italy, awards scholarships to eighth grade students through our Dante Commission on Education/Culture. This year grants of \$500 each will be awarded to Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania children who have been **members of the Order for 2 years prior to application or whose parent(s) have been member(s) (including social members) of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania for 2 years prior to application**, who will complete 8th grade at the end of the 2025-2026 school year and plan to enter a private or parochial high school in the Fall of 2026.

To be eligible to compete for a grant from the Dante Commission, you must have an overall **grade average of at least B+ or 88**. Membership in the Order (**child or their parent**) must predate the application by at least two (2) years.

If you are interested in applying for a grant, complete the attached scholarship application. Give the enclosed letter and forms to your school principal to complete. Also be sure to provide a stamped envelope addressed to the **Dante Commission on Education/Culture**. Remind your principal or guidance counselor to send the transcript and forms directly to our office. In addition, a typed 250-300 word essay described in the attached rules.

Your completed application must be received at the Grand Lodge office by **April 30, 2026** to be considered. Please note that the President of the lodge to which membership in The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, Sons and Daughters of Italy is based must also sign your application.

HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS 2026

The Dante Commission on Education/Culture awards merit-based grants of \$500.00 each. These grants will be awarded to eighth grade students who are enrolled to attend his or her freshman year in a private/parochial high school in September 2026. These grants will be funded by the Charitable & Education Trust, which supports the efforts of the Grand Lodge on behalf of quality education for Italian-American youths.

Eligibility

- 1) Only eighth grade students may apply.
- 2) Applicant must have overall average of B (85) during their 7th and 8th grade years.
- 3) Applicant must be a member or a child of a member of the Grand Lodge of PA, SDI
- 4) Membership must predate application by at least two years.

Requirements for Grant Competition

- 1) Completed application must be received at the Grand Lodge by **April 30, 2026**.
- 2) The academic institution attended during 2025-2026 must submit official transcript. All transcripts must be stamped by the institution and included in a separate, sealed envelope. Transcripts of the applicant's 7th grade and the first semester of 8th grade marks must be received at the Grand Lodge office by **April 30, 2026**.
- 3) A typed 250-300 word essay describing their unique life and contributions to America must be submitted about one of the following Italians:

Dr. Maria Montessori

The essay must include a bibliography with a minimum of two sources, of which at least one source is print (i.e. book, magazine article, etc.). If computer source is utilized, website/author must be listed. Essays will be qualified on three criteria: a) Adherence to topic, b) Quality of presentation and originality, and c) Mechanics (grammar and spelling). Grading of essays and selection of winning candidates is made by the Dante Commission.

Dear School Principal:

The transcript supplement form will assist the selection committee in assuring fairness when comparing academic histories.

Please submit all documents for the student to the above address. The forms must be received by **April 30, 2026** for the student to be considered for a grant.
