Dear High School Senior:

The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, Sons and Daughters of Italy, award college scholarships to high school seniors through our Grand Lodge and Dante Commission on Education/Culture. Various merit based awards can be earned by **children who have been members of the Order for two (2) years prior to application or whose parent(s) (including social members) have been member(s) of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania for two (2) years prior to application** and who will complete high school at the end of the 2025-2026 school year. **Children must be attending an undergraduate college/university, trade school, law enforcement or military training in the Fall of 2026.**

To be eligible to compete for a grant from the Dante Commission, you must have an overall **grade average** of, at least, **3.5, B+, or 88 GPA. Membership in the Order must predate the application by at least two (2) years.**

It is also required that you submit a one-page essay on **“what it means for you to be Italian”.**

If you are interested in applying for a grant, complete the attached scholarship application. Give the enclosed letter and forms to your school principal to complete. Also be sure to provide a stamped envelope addressed to the ***Dante Commission on Education/Culture***. Remind your principal or guidance counselor to send the transcript and forms directly to our office.

Your completed application must be received at the Grand Lodge office by **April 30, 2026** to be considered. Please note that the President of the lodge to which membership in Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, Sons and Daughters of Italy is based must also sign your application.

The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, Sons and Daughters of Italy, will provide merit based scholarships to members who will complete high school at the end of the 2025-2026 school year and enter an **undergraduate college/university, trade school, law enforcement or military training in the Fall of 2026**. Many factors are reviewed in the grant awarding process. Key among the elements considered are:

- High School grade point average.
- Major subject marks received for the first semester of senior year.
- The difficulty of the high school subjects taken.
- SAT - Verbal and Math scores (ACT scores if SAT results are not available)
- **It is very important that all transcripts be submitted on time so the student stays eligible.**

Each applicant must submit a transcript bearing the high school's seal and the attached transcript supplement form also bearing the seal of the institution and signed by the principal. The transcript supplement form will assist the selection committee in assuring fairness when comparing academic histories.

Please submit all documents for the student to the above address. The forms must be received by **April 30, 2026** for the student to be considered for a grant.

Please accept our appreciation for your assistance in helping to identify scholarship recipients. You will be notified if the applicant will receive a scholarship. Notification will be sent prior to date of commencement so that you may add him/her to your commencement program.
