#### **Supply List:**

- 4 inch paper plates
- Paint pens or markers
- Curling ribbon
- Paper straws or Jumbo popsicle sticks
- Craft pom poms
- Beans any small, dry variety
- Hot glue gun & glue sticks
- Additional themed craft items, if desired

#### Assembly:

- Decorate the **backside** of two paper plates in any desired theme or design.
  - I like to coordinate the designs since one plate will be used for the front of the noisemaker and one for the back.
- Glue the straw or popsicle stick to the **inside** of the backside plate as shown. .
  - If using a straw, flatten the portion that will be glued to the plate to make final assembly easier.
  - Also be sure to attach about halfway into the plate for stability
- Place a small amount of beans in the plate, just above where the handle is glued.
- Hot glue an even bead of glue all the way around the outside ring of the plate and carefully • place the front plate on top and slightly press down until set
- Add curling ribbon and additional décor where the plate and handle meet to finish the look.




