Individual Liability Insurance, Creating a Trade Name, & Incorporating as an LLC

Contracting requirements for independent business includes:

- A Contract with our agency
- Liability insurance
- Secretary of State Registration (Legal Zoom, Trade Name will need to be renewed every 5-10 years)
- Any licenses you may have (CNA, RN, etc.)

The ONE-TIME total cost to fulfill all of these requirements should be around \$300.00. There will be an annual charge of around \$100.00 for individual liability insurance each year after.

Individual Liability Insurance

For individual liability insurance, we recommend going through the Nurses Service Organization (NSO). You do not have to be a nurse to get individual liability insurance though this organization. The following link will bring you to their main website, where you will be able to get a quote and apply for Individual Liability Insurance.

For full time and part time independent contractors, the annual price for individual liability insurance should be around \$111.00. This is a yearly cost and will be billed 2 months prior to renewal. You will get an invoice before you are charged.



Creating a Trade Name

A trade name is a name used by a manufacturer, merchant, service company, farming business, etc., to identify itself individually as a business. The website that we would recommend using is Legal Zoom. It will cost roughly \$99+ to file a trade name through Legal Zoom, but these costs are often tax deductible. Does a trade name expire?

In most states and counties, you need to renew your trade name every 5-10 years. Trade names never expire in a few states like Indiana, Iowa, and New York.


Does a trade name give me liability protection?

No. You need to form an LLC, corporation, or nonprofit to get limited liability protection.

Incorporating as an LLC
