

Make your own Hocus Pocus footprint art!




Project Needs:

- Printer Paper
- Acrylic paint in Purple, Orange, and Green
- Paintbrush
- Colored Pens, Pencils, or Markers

Pick your witchy color, and paint on the bottom of your child's foot. Have your child plant their foot on the paper and gently press their foot into it (we taped our paper to the fridge for easier application with squirmy kids).

Next you can use colored pens or pencils to apply hair and accent items. Make it your own!





We understand the importance of privacy, if you do not want to use your real signature, initials are fine. Just please make them the same every time. Not just a scribble.




