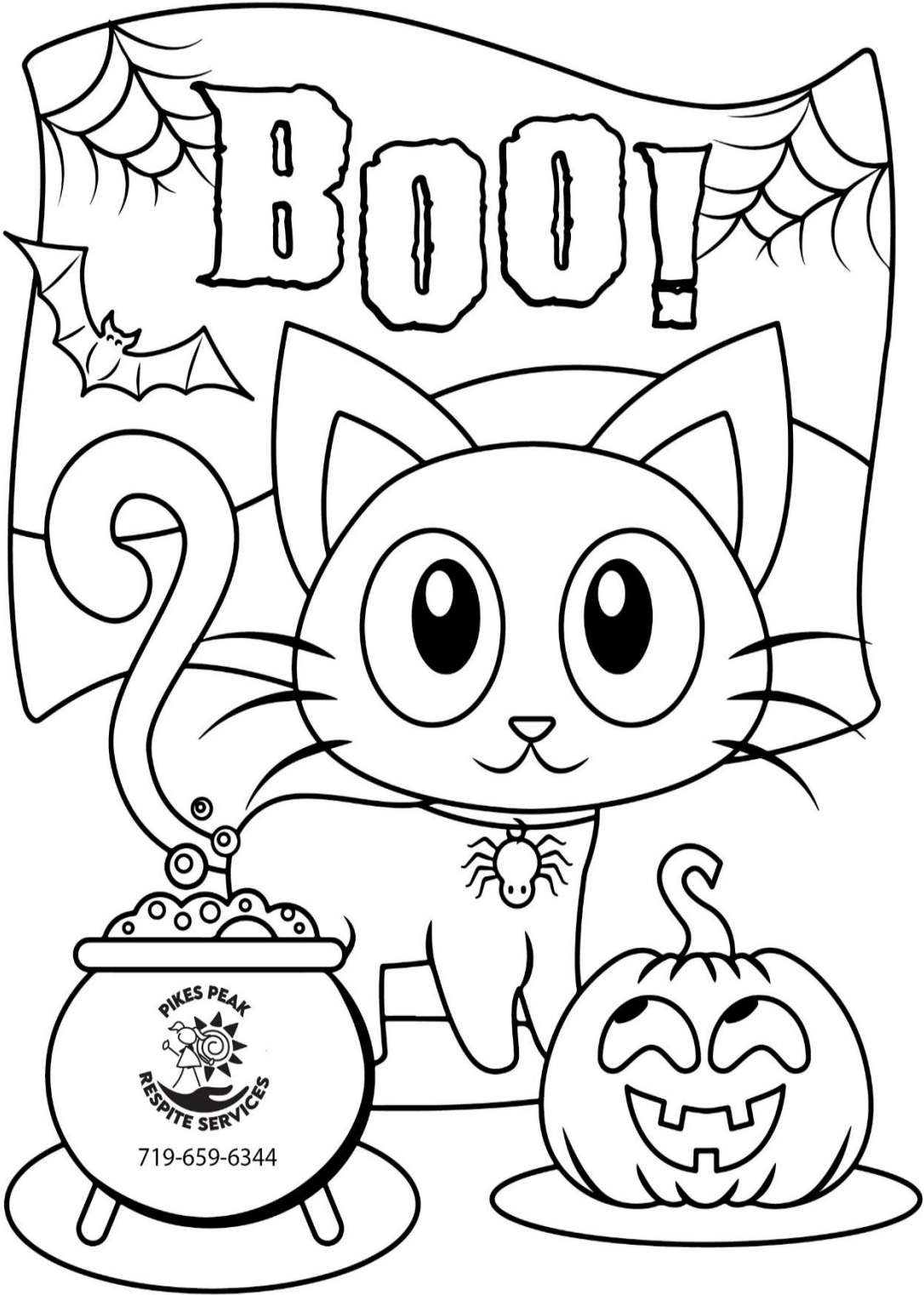

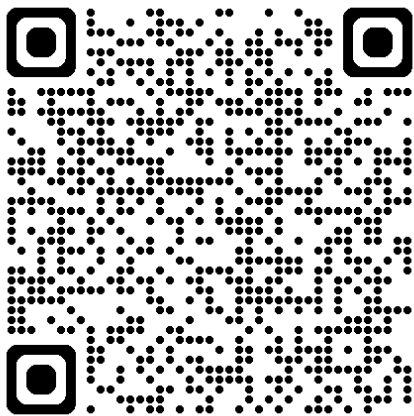
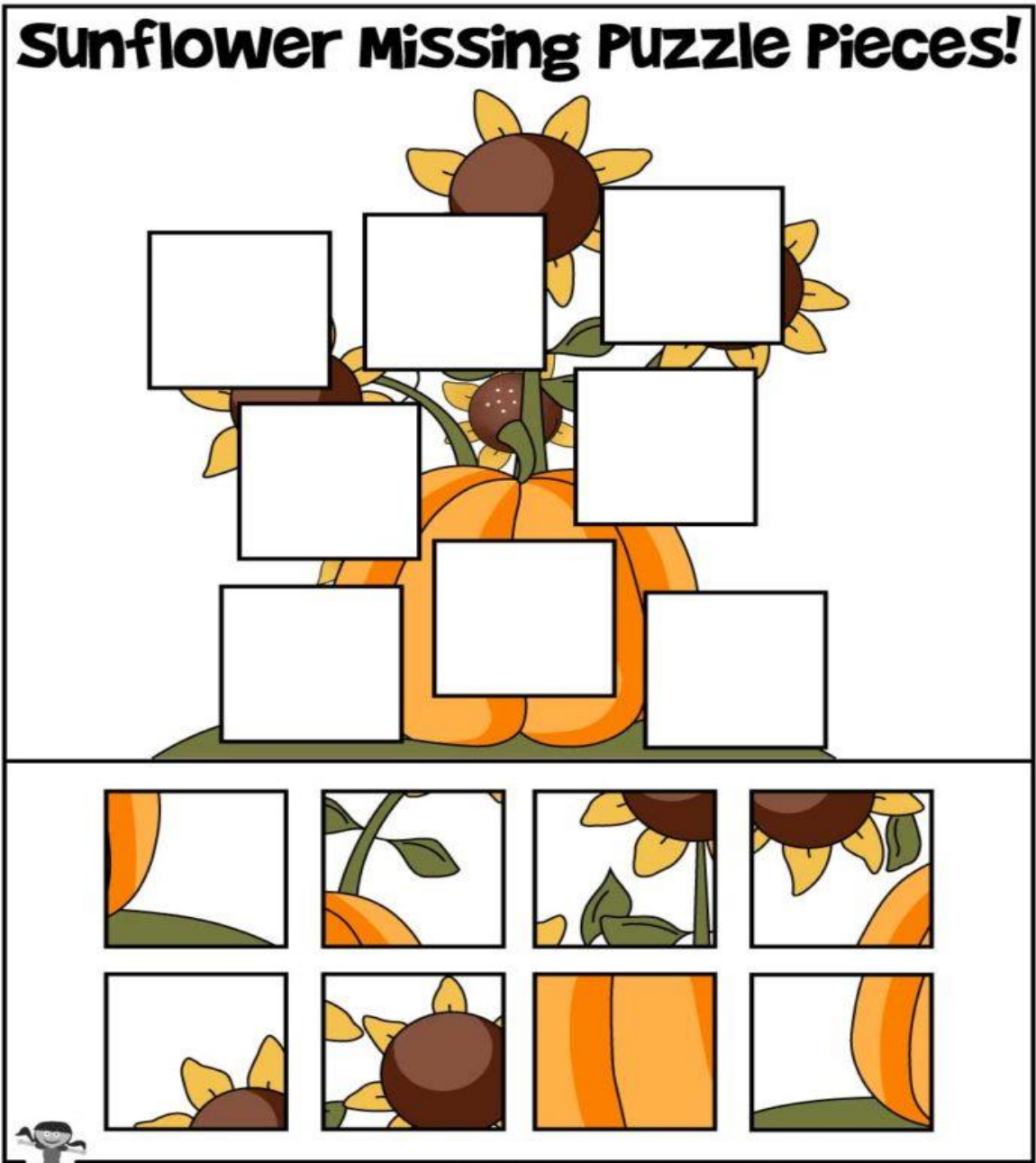
Project Needs:

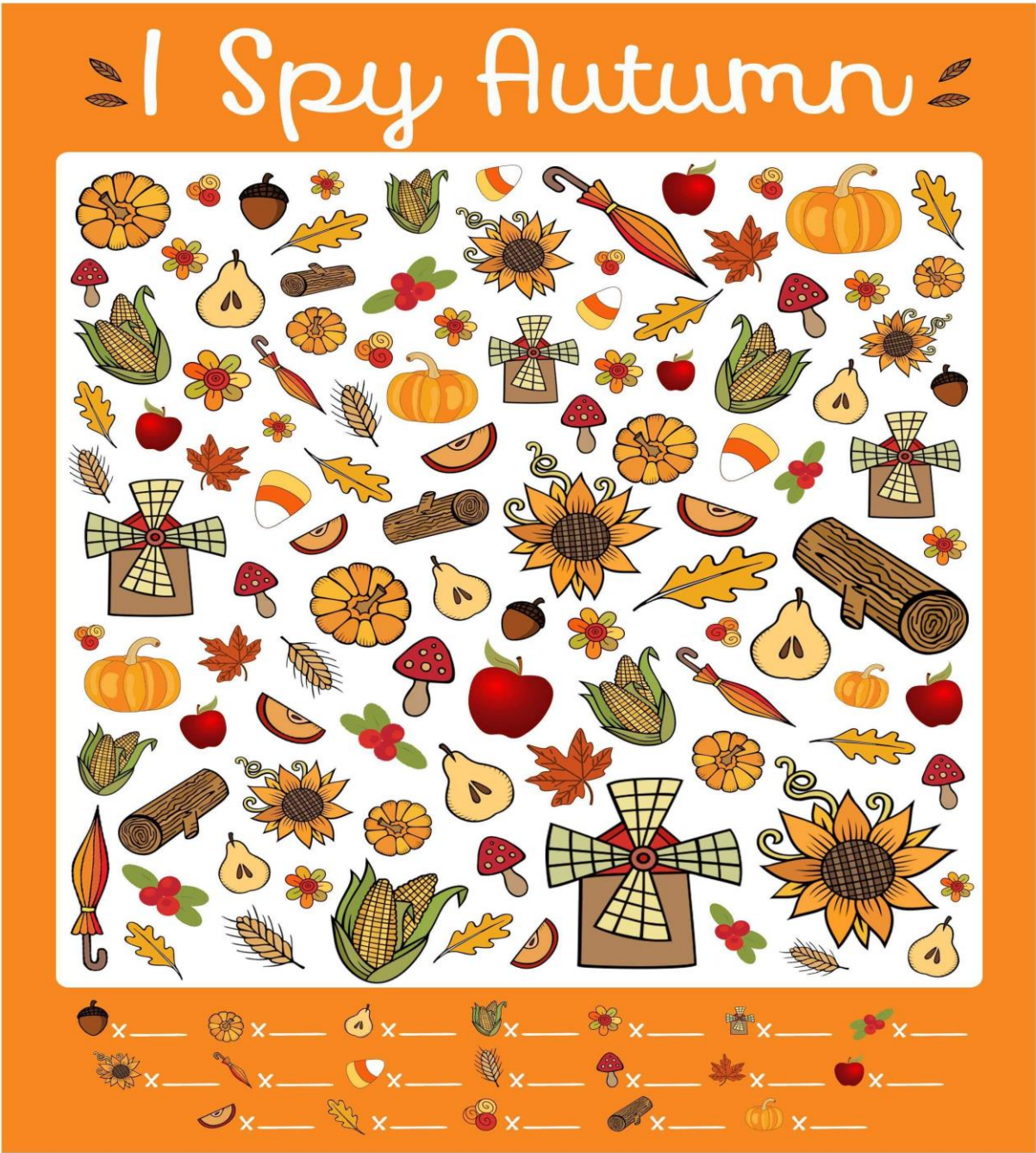
- **Printer Paper**
- **Acrylic paint in Purple, Orange, and Green**
- **Paintbrush**
- **Colored Pens, Pencils, or Markers**

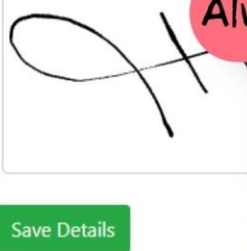
When signing make your initials or signature legible
