✨ The Genesis Series: Genesis 1:1 In the beginning...

The Genesis Series was created to provide a dedicated platform for developing, showcasing, and elevating young performance horses within the sport of Cowboy Mounted Shooting. Our purpose is to encourage responsible training, early foundational development, and long-term soundness in future competition horses while offering riders a structured, rewarding pathway for bringing young equine athletes into the shooting arena. Through a Futurity and Derby format, we seek to grow the sport, strengthen horsemanship, and honor the true beginning—the genesis—of every great shooting horse. The series also exists to highlight rising equine talent, promote the trainers who build these horses, and increase visibility and value for stallions and breeding programs contributing to the future of our sport.

The Beginning of a Champion

Every outstanding mounted shooting horse begins with a thoughtful foundation. The Genesis Series honors that beginning by offering a platform dedicated to 4-, 5-, and 6-year-old horses as they enter the sport. This provides a fair, age-appropriate pathway that protects young equine athletes while showcasing the skill, patience, and horsemanship required to develop a future champion. We strive to shape the next generation of equine partners who will carry riders safely and competitively for years to come.

What Is a Futurity and Why Is It Important?

A *futurity* is designed for 4-year-old horses who have never competed in a sanctioned match. Its purpose is to:

- **Promote slow, thoughtful training** that focuses on fundamentals instead of rushing a horse to the arena too soon.
- **Encourage breeders and trainers** to produce and develop high-quality shooting prospects.
- **Reward trainers** who invest the time and skill to bring a young horse along the right way.
- **Promote breeders and stallion owners** by highlighting the talent and potential of their offspring.
- **Provide a fair playing field** where all horses are at a similar stage in their training.
- **Reward the time, patience, and investment** that goes into building a future champion.

The futurity stage is where confidence is built and foundation is strengthened. In mounted shooting, a futurity horse is learning to balance speed with confidence, handle the unique environment of navigating a course, gunfire, and form a strong partnership with its rider.

The Purpose of the Derby: The Next Step Forward

The *derby* category—designed for 5- and 6-year-old horses—serves as the natural bridge between the careful introduction of a futurity and the intensity of full open competition. A derby is important to:

- **Develop a young horse's confidence** by allowing it to progress through competition gradually.
- **Help horses mature mentally and physically** while still competing against peers rather than seasoned veterans.
- **Encourage longevity**, reducing burnout or over-pressuring horses too early.
- **Reward consistent training** by allowing futurity horses to continue their journey or giving new horses a first competitive season.
- **Allows trainers to showcase ongoing progress** and the depth of their training program.
- **Gives breeders and stallion owners extended visibility** as their offspring continue to perform.

The derby phase rewards consistency, correct training, and patient horsemanship.



How Futurity & Derby Programs Strengthen the Entire Sport

1. Promoting Riders, Trainers, and Training Programs

Futurity and derby events shine a spotlight on the horsemen and horsewomen developing the next wave of competitive shooting horses.

These programs:

THE GENESIS SERIES - Rules and Guidelines

SECTION 1 — ELIGIBILITY

1.1 Futurity Horses

A **Futurity horse** is defined as:

- Any **registered breed horse**
- 4-year-old as of January 1 of the competition year, regardless of the horse's actual foaling date within that year
- **Cannot have competed** in any competitive mounted shooting match prior to their 4 year old year (their 3-year-old year or before)

1.2 Derby Horses

A **Derby horse** is defined as:

- Any **registered breed horse**
- 5 or 6-year-old as of January 1 of the competition year, regardless of the horse's actual foaling date within that year
- **Does NOT need to have been a futurity entry in previous year** to enter the Derby
- Derby horses are not restricted by prior competition history

1.3 Sweepstakes Horses

To qualify for the Sweepstakes division, the following conditions apply:

- The horse must have been entered in at least one Genesis Futurity or Derby class in any prior season
- All Sweepstakes entries must be current Genesis Series members prior to competition
- Non-members are not permitted to enter or compete in the Sweepstakes due to the incentive-based nature of this class and its associated awards
- If a horse competed in a prior season without holding an active Genesis Series membership, the owner must activate that horse's eligibility by paying a one-time, first-year post-pay Sweepstakes membership fee of \$150, in addition to the current year's membership fee
- This post-pay fee is required only once, in the first year the owner requests Sweepstakes Series membership for a previously non-member horse

1.4 Registration Papers

- A **copy** of the horse's registration papers **must be submitted and in hand** prior to competition
- Registration papers need only be submitted once; horses with papers already on file are not required to resubmit them at each event

SECTION 2 — MEMBERSHIP & FEES

2.1 Series Membership

- **\$150 annual membership applies to the horse**
- Required to be eligible for:
 - **Year-End High Point Saddles and prizes**
 - **Perpetual Award Plaque** with event placings
 - **Perfect Shooter Award** eligibility
 - **Recognition in the show book, online placings, website listings, and social media posts**, with acknowledgement given to the horse's stallion, breeder, trainer, and rider

2.2 Event Entry Fees \$150

- \$40 — Host club
 - \$10 — Genesis Series
 - \$100 — Payback
-

SECTION 3 — POINTS, RIDER RULES & PROCEDURES

3.1 Points Calculation

- Points, placings, penalties, and Perfect Shooter eligibility are **attached to the horse**, not the rider
- **Any rider may ride the horse** at any event
- Horse can only be entered once in Genesis series match
- Each horse will earn 5 points for every horse it places above within its class, including 5 points for itself.
- Points are calculated based on final placings at each individual Genesis Series event
- In the event of a tie in total year-end points, the horse with the higher placing at the Final Series Event will be declared the Series Champion

3.2 If Horse is Entered as a Rider's Main Match Horse

- All Genesis Series competitors need to run during the designated Genesis Series section of the stage
- The rider **must ride the main match horse FIRST** in the Series runs, **before** riding any other horses
- If a horse is used by multiple riders the rider using the horse as their **main match and Genesis Series** must ride that horse **first**
- Match Director may approve a change in the above rule in extenuating circumstances where running during the designated Genesis Series section in described order is not possible or not practical

3.3 Assigned Horse Numbers

- Each horse will receive a **Genesis Series number** at every event
- The number **must be worn on the saddle pad**, on the side chosen by the match director for optimal visibility by the scoring team
- Numbers are provided by the Genesis Series

SECTION 4 — EVENT PRIZES AND PAYOUT

4.1 Recognition & Payout Distribution

- Both **owner and rider** will be announced at each event
- **Event prize money** is paid to the **rider** listed on the event registration for that specific class.
- **Year-end prizes, awards, perfect shooter, and accolades** shall be issued to the **recorded owner** of the horse unless the owner provides **written authorization** designating the rider or another individual to receive them
- A horse registry will be prepared and provided by the Genesis Series for all horses entered at least 10 days prior to the event. This registry will include breeder, stallion, trainer, and rider information and will be made available for distribution to event attendees

4.2 Event Ribbons & Awards

- **Ribbons** will be awarded for **1st, 2nd, and 3rd place** in Futurity, Derby, and Sweepstakes divisions
 - Ribbons are **supplied by the Genesis Series**
-

SECTION 5 — HOST CLUB REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Added Money Requirement

- Host club must provide **\$1,000 minimum added money**. Split: **\$500 Futurity** and **\$500 Derby**
- May come from the club or other sponsorships
- Must be **included in prize money payout calculations**

5.2 Facility & Event Requirements

- Event/Match must have a minimum of 4 stages
- Arena must be **minimum 120' x 200'** unless prior authorization by Genesis Series staff.
- Must be **covered or indoor arena**
- Must offer:
 - Ample warm-up arena space, adequate footing, lighting, and safety measures
 - **Enclosed stalls** (no panel stalls or panel gates similar to round pen gates allowed)

5.2 Office & Data Management – Host Club Responsibilities

- Accepting and processing registry forms and horse papers for all non–pre-registered entries
- Assigning horse numbers (supplied by the Genesis Series)
- Ensuring the correct horse is ridden according to submitted paperwork
- Issuing prize checks and ribbons at the conclusion of the event
- Collecting and transferring \$10 of each \$150 Genesis Series entry fee, as well as the full \$150 Series membership fee for all new members, to the Genesis Series
- Making the Genesis Series Guidebook and official Horse Registry (provided by the Genesis Series) available to all attendees throughout the event

5.3 Software, Forms, & Calculations

- All scoring software, forms, and calculations are **provided by the Genesis Series**
- The host must maintain accurate time and penalty entry throughout the event

5.4 Sponsorship Recognition

- The host club agrees to honor and execute all Genesis Series sponsor recognition requirements and offerings as outlined in Section 7 at:
 - Every event
 - Awards ceremonies
 - Social media promotions including Genesis Series Information
 - Printed promotional materials including Genesis Series Information

SECTION 6: SERIES YEAR-END MEMBERS ONLY

6.1 High Point Awards

- **Year-End Futurity High Point Saddle**
- **Year-End Derby High Point Saddle**
- **Year-End Sweepstakes High Point Saddle (starting in 2027)**

6.2 Perpetual Plaques

- A perpetual recognition plaque will be given to each member at series end
 - Heading plate with horse name
 - Event plate with placing at each event

6.3 Perfect Shooter

- A minimum **\$500 pot** will be split among **any Futurity or Derby** horses that complete **at least 7 of the 8 events with zero penalties**

6.4 Additional Awards

- Additional prizes, sponsor awards, and special recognitions may be given throughout the season.

6.5 Guidebook Listing & Event Horse Registry

- Guidebook Listing: Horses enrolled in the Genesis Series at least three (2) months prior to the event to be included in the annual Genesis Series Guidebook
- Horses entered in the match no later than 10 days prior to the event will appear in the official Event Horse Registry
- Listings may include breeder, stallion, trainer, and rider information as applicable.

SECTION 7: Summary of CMSA Rule Applicability to the Genesis Series

7.1 CMSA Rules Fully Adopted for Genesis Classes

The following are **examples** of CMSA rules that apply in full to all Genesis Futurity, Derby, and Sweepstakes matches.

(This is not an exhaustive list. CMSA rules apply unless they conflict with a Genesis Series rule. In such cases, the Genesis rule supersedes the CMSA rule.)

A. General CMSA Conduct, Ethics & Match Rules that apply

- **Safety Rules & General Conduct Standards**
(Firearm handling, crowd safety, arena entry/exit, sportsmanship)
- **Firearms, Ammunition & Holstering Requirements**
(Approved blanks, firearm specifications, loading/unloading procedures)
- **Dress Code & Equipment Standards**
(Unless a CMSA-approved promotional exception is granted to the show host)
- **Official Course of Fire / Patterns**
(Balloon placement, course markers, directional requirements)
- **Timing & Penalty Rules**
(Missed balloons, dropped gun, procedural penalties, off-course, etc.)
- **Arena & Range Requirements**
(balloon type, course, match official authority)

B. CMSA Standard Payout Structure

- Standard CMSA payout formula of **1 hole per every 5 riders**
- CMSA/rodeo-style percentage splits apply.
 - Examples: **60/40, 50/30/20, 40/30/20/10, etc.**

C. CMSA Membership Requirement

- All Genesis competitors/riders must hold a **valid and current CMSA membership**.

D. Rider Eligibility

- Riders competing in any Genesis Series class (**Futurity, Derby, or Sweepstakes**) **must also be entered in the CMSA Main Match** at that same event.
- **Exception:** This requirement does *not* apply when a Genesis Series event is held independently and **not** in conjunction with a CMSA-sanctioned Main Match

These adopted CMSA rules ensure that all Genesis rounds follow the established safety, fairness, and structural standards of CMSA competition.

7.2 CMSA Rules Modified or Superseded by Genesis Series Rules

The following CMSA provisions do **not** apply to Genesis classes and are replaced by Genesis-specific guidelines.

A. Class & Rider Division Structure

- CMSA rider levels (**L1–L6**, Senior Men/Ladies, gender divisions, Wrangler/Buckaroo, etc.) **are not used** for Genesis standings or payouts
- Genesis divisions are determined solely by:
 - **Futurity:** A 4-year-old as of January 1 of the competition year, regardless of the horse's actual foaling date within that year
 - **Derby:** A 5 or 6-year-old as of January 1 of the competition year, regardless of the horse's actual foaling date within that year.
 - **Sweepstakes:** Any horse previously entered in a Genesis Futurity or Derby class
- All entrants in each Genesis category compete in **one unified division** (no Open/Non-Pro split; no gender split)
- **CMSA levels do not affect eligibility, scoring, or payouts** in Genesis classes
- Riders must be a **CMSA Level 1 or higher**
 - *Wranglers (Open or Limited) are not permitted to enter*
- Youth, wrangler, senior, and gender-based CMSA divisions **do not apply** to Genesis classes
- Genesis results **do not count** toward CMSA level advancement or CMSA standings

B. Ancillary Classes (Rifle, Shotgun, Cavalry)

- The Genesis Series is a **two-pistol main match** format only.
 - CMSA ancillary classes (Rifle, Shotgun, Cavalry) **are not offered** and their rules **do not apply**.

3. Enforcement & Authority

- The **Match Director** and **Range Master** will enforce CMSA rules where adopted and Genesis rules where specified.
 - In the event of a rule conflict:
Genesis rules supersede CMSA rules
 - If no Genesis rule applies, the **CMSA rulebook** serves as the default authority
-

Summary Statement for Competitors

- The Genesis Series follows CMSA **safety, firearm, dress, timing, and arena** rules.
- All **eligibility requirements, horse age rules, and membership standards** are governed by Genesis policies.
- CMSA rider levels and youth/wrangler/senior/gender divisions **do not apply** to Genesis standings or payouts.
- When in doubt, **Genesis rules take precedence** over CMSA rules.
- If a topic is not addressed by Genesis regulations, **default to CMSA rules**.
