AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

RULES – This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF Arabian Horse Division. The Official Rule Book of the USEF will prevail for this show. This Premium List is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show committee shall decide questions not covered. USEF Rules and its decisions will be final.

Every Class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith, except as modified by the Prize List.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE – Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration as certified by the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc (or in the case of a foreign entry, which has not been issued said certificate of registration, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Registry of America.) and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for (Exception:AR236.1) and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) **ANY HORSE OVER ONE YEAR OF AGE MUST HAVE A COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS – NO PENDING PAPERS.**

Horses shown in the Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian sections must have been issued a certificate of registration as certified by the Arabian Horse Association and/or the Canadian Part Bred Arabian Registry or, if under one year be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. A copy of registration papers FRONT AND BACK, showing proof of ownership **MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.**

In the case of a lease, a copy of the last registration certificate must be submitted with a statement of the current ownership and a copy of the lease contract. It is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with a copy of the registration papers. Combined ownership is not allowed in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the family. (See USEF definitions) Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate partnership/corporation name may not be shown in Amateur Owner classes unless the family is the sole owner of the farm. (BOD1/99) Corporations or farms with multiple owners which are not the same family (as defined by USEF rules) are not eligible to exhibit horses in Amateur Owner Classes. (BOD2/89) **Horses entered in Amateur or Junior owner classes must be registered in name of owner, owner's family or farm if its family owned. Contract of Sale or Bill of Sale WILL NOT be accepted. A sales contract or even the back of papers signed over to you WILL NOT be accepted. You may not show in AO or JO classes unless papers are in your name.**

COPIES OF AHA CARDS – Owners, trainers, riders/handlers/drivers must provide a copy of their current AHA membership card with their entry form. AHA non-members MUST pay \$40 non-member fee for AHA, or you may join these organization through the secretary, or www.arabianhorses.org be sure to choose a **competition card** in order to show.

Choose affiliate club # 7014 Utah AHC to be eligible for local awards.

USEF – **There will be NO USEF memberships needed for this show.**

CANCELLATION OR SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES – The manager agrees to refund all fees applicable on a horse considered not fit to show provided a Vet Certificate is given to Show Secretary on or before the **closing date**. Class fees (not administration or stall fees) will be refunded to exhibitors canceling their entries with a Vet Certificate after closing date. No fees will be refunded for any other reason after the official closing date. Substitution horses will be permitted in accordance with USEF Article 1506. Any entry shown in a class which they are not entered may be disqualified. Scratched classes can be substituted, but will NOT be refunded.

DISCIPLINE – Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials or show personnel on the part of the owner, groom, rider, trainer, handler, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The show management reserves the right to remove a trainer, groom, horse, handler, owner, rider or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

JUDGES – In the event that due to illness or failure of a judge to attend a show or to perform the duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Premium List. USEF rule XII, article 1211. It is a violation to USEF rules to commit any act or make any remarks during the show that are considered offensive made with intent to influence or cause aspersion on the judging USEF rule VII. Any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

INDEMNITY & NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES – Utah Arabian Horse Club will not be responsible for any losses or damages or injury to any horse exhibited, or any article of any kind that may be lost, damaged or destroyed. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury or damage that may be occasioned to any person, animal or property whatsoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the Utah Arabian Horse Club and all show officials against all claims. The submitting of any Entry Form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth. All horses will be exhibited in the show entirely at the owner's risk.

PROTEST – GR603 Any rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor may file a protest with the Show Committee or The Federation Hearing Committee alleging violation of any Federation rule(s). The protest must be: a. in writing, b. signed by the protester, c. addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, or to the Hearing Committee, d. accompanied by a deposit of \$200 if made by a Federation member or the parent of a junior exhibitor member or \$300 if made by a Federation Nonmember (if check payable to the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation, or if made directly to the Hearing Committee, it must be received at the Federation office by the fifth business day following the last recognized day of the competition, or by the fifth business day following the date on which the alleged violation occurred if it occurred other than at a competition.

CLASS CALLS – Exhibitors are reminded that although every reasonable effort will be made to maintain a functional public address system throughout the grounds and make adequate class calls, this service is a courtesy. UAHC cannot be responsible for equipment malfunction. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her horse at the in-gate at the appropriate time.**

GATE LIMIT – Exhibitors are warned about entering successive classes. Show will be running according to the 2 minute USEF rule. (the in-gate must be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring) Schedule conflicts are the responsibility of the exhibitor. **Gate/tack holds will be granted on a case by case basis and must be approved by the Show Manager.**

TBA CLASSES – TBA classes may come from any section of the Arabian Division of the USEF rulebook **with the exception** of sport horse, over fences, dressage, trail and cow classes. These classes will not offer purse money. Procedures for entering the classes will be available in the show office. 2+ entries for a class – Each pays class fee only – NO sponsorship Fee!
One entry for a class – Pays class fee & will be billed \$15 sponsor fee (that's the fee AHA charges us to add a TBA).

Adding any class after session starts = \$5 /class.

TBA classes to be held will be announced and posted in the show office. You can contact Jill anytime between now and the show to add a TBA and the class schedule will be updated on the web. Championships can be added as TBAs.

CAMPERS: You may park your RV at the show grounds, but RV water/sewer hook-ups are **not** available. Prices are:
20 amps = \$20/day - 30 amps = \$25/day - 50 amps = \$35/day

PARKING – **No parking between 700 & 800 Barns.** Vehicles will be towed.

DOGS – **No dogs on mezzanine** in the SJ Equestrian Center. This is the facility rule. Dogs **must** be kept on a leash at all times. Owners assume all liability for pets and animals. SJ Animal Control does patrol the grounds and will seize any dog not on a leash.

SESSION START TIMES – The session start times indicate that session will not start prior to the posted time, but may be adjusted later by the show committee as necessary to properly run the show.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS – Any class with fewer than three entries after Close of Entries may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be combined with another class or canceled, and the exhibitors in the class (s) will be notified accordingly. Some age divisions have been combined in some classes. **Large classes may be divided and conducted as two separate classes with duplicate awards**, except Championship performance classes.

BREAKS - The Show Committee reserves the right to adjust breaks in length and scheduling as needed by the show scheduling and to allow the show to run as continuously and smoothly as possible.

SHOW OFFICE – The show office will be open from 4-7 pm on Wednesday. The office will be open one hour prior to the beginning of the first session of the day. **On Thursday, Friday, and Sat., the show office will close 15 min. after the last class of the session.** Show Office will close briefly during dinner and/or lunch.

All entries must be paid by an OPEN CHECK or be paid BEFORE entering arena. A check must be included with your entries. You can pay with cash or credit card and have your check returned to you when closing your account at the end of the show. **No numbers will be given out without an open check.** All classes must be entered ½ hour before the start of the session. Post marks must be made on or before Date Printed as Deadline! Bounced checks will be charged a \$35 fee.

Horses registration papers (or copies of) front and back for Arabian and front only for Half Arabian, **must** accompany your entry form. Copies of AHA cards for riders/handlers, trainers and check to UAHC must also accompany your entry. Any **incomplete entry** received even by the closing date (**Tues, Apr 28th**) **WILL BE CHARGED** a **\$30 post-entry fee**. There will be no exceptions. You may *add* more classes at the show without paying a post-entry fee.

STABLING FACILITIES – NOTE stall requests are given priority by the postage date on the entry form. Stalls are \$85.00 for the show from noon Wednesday thru Sunday morning at noon. Any additional days will be charged \$25 per day. All 10x10 stalls have doors. Stall doors are provided. The barn manager will handle bedding requirements. All horses trailered in at this show must pay a stall fee. Participants are liable for any damages to the stalls or the fairgrounds incurred by them or their horse. Horses are not to be tied to trailers. Horses are not to be left in trailers for more time than it takes to reasonably load/unload the trailer.

ADMISSION TO ARENA: No person will be permitted to enter the arena except the judges, their assistants, the exhibitors in the class. The headers will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the Judge. Show arena 100x210, clay base/sand. Warm up arena 100x180 Clay base/sand.

VETERINARIAN SERVICES – A Veterinarian will be on call and available during show. Information will be posted in the Show Office. All services are CASH basis.

FARRIER SERVICES – A farrier will be NOT available on the grounds during all show sessions.

SHARPS CONTAINERS – GR1210.4 Competition management shall provide at least one sharps container per competition whether or not stabling is provided. If stabling is provided, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls must be placed in convenient

locations in the barns housing the competition horses. GR1210.4 also states that management 1 fine individuals \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharps.

Accidents Involving Competitors – Return to Completion (GR 1317.2) In the event of a fall/accident where the competitor is apparently unconscious or concussed, he/she is precluded from competing until evaluated by qualified medical personnel as defined in GR1211.5. If the competitor refuses to be evaluated, he is disqualified from the competition.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES - In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parents(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CLOSE OF PRE-ENTRIES - PRE-ENTRIES close midnight Tues, April 28th, 2026 and must be postmarked accordingly. Post-entries will be accepted after Deadline and at the show and WILL BE CHARGED a \$30 post-entry fee.

EQUITATION – Arabian and Half Arabian Rule XVI, chapter XXI, Article 1692. Refer to current AHA Handbook.

AHA MEDAL CLASS REQUIREMENTS - See USEF/EC rulebook. Medals will be awarded in classes with 3 or more entries. Classes with less than 3 entries will earn medal points.

Halter classes will be run with an in ring procedure.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS – For AHA, one who has not, as of December 1st of the previous year, reached his/her 19th birthday.

STATUS AND DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES:

MAIDEN: A "Maiden" class is open to horses who have not won any first place ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Maiden" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

NOVICE: A "Novice" class is open to horses/ride who have not won the three first place ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Novice" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

LIMIT: A "Limit" class is open to horses who not won six first place ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Limit" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

ATR SELECT: Please refer to the AHA Handbook for leveling rules and additional requirements and information. COMP 719.

Academy classes (formerly Acts) - Academy classes are NOT AHA sanctioned or rated classes. They do not count towards AHA qualification points and will not be on your horse's show record. They require a separate entry form and have their own rules and regulations.. Contact Jill (801-979-5279 for questions and details.

NEW *We have changed the clothing rules for Academy (Acts) classes.* You can still use the old white shirt, black jeans uniform that we've used in previous years. But, we are going to allow 'typical' academy clothing/tack, * A neatly fitted shirt or top with riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or jeans. (no chaps, no show coats, no excessive 'bling', UAHC membership required, pays \$25 office fee per horse & \$15 per class.

Academy High point will be counted up just like rated high point/end of year awards. So, you do not HAVE to show pleasure/horsemanship, equitation, and showmanship classes to be considered for high point, but obviously, the more classes you show in, the more points you earn. See attached rules.

The Training Tack Classes are open to any breed horse. Show or training tack/clothing is allowed, but not required. Horses and riders can cross enter into regular classes. ***ALL horses are welcome, any breed, registered or unregistered, horse or rider does NOT have to be entered in the rated Arabian Show. *** \$15 per class + \$25 office fee to be pre-entered please.

Class will be called (gates to be called are listed) and a line up conducted. Placing and ribbons will be awarded for amateur (ATR) and junior (JTR) classes. Approximately 2 minutes will be allowed between training classes for participants to change horses, if needed.

Horses are not to be tied to trailers. Horses are not to be left in trailers for more time than it takes to reasonably load/unload the trailer.

NEW **Open Breed** Performance classes – ***ALL horses are welcome, any breed, registered or unregistered, horse or rider does NOT have to be entered in the rated Arabian Show. Show clothing/tack required. \$20 a class, \$25 office fee per horse. Will be judged by USEF rules. Class will be called, and a line up conducted. Placing and ribbons will be awarded for all classes. Open Breed classes are NOT AHA sanctioned or rated classes. They do not count towards AHA qualification points and will not be on your horse's show record. **All Breed TBA classes can be put anywhere in the schedule as an added "A" to the previous class #. All breed class TBAs will be charged a \$5 extra fee if the session has already started.**

- STALL RESERVATIONS: Contact Barn Manager after mailing entries.**

If you are not sending your entries in with a Trainer, call Crystal to tell her how many stalls you need and who you want to be stalled with or near AND how many bags of shavings you will need.

The stalls will NOT be available for move-in/setup before Tues @ noon (700 barn only).

No outside shavings can be brought in. Yes, this is a new rule that will be enforced.
Please PRE-ORDER shavings with Crystal when reserving your stall.

If you need a TBA added, let Jill know and she can update the class schedule ahead of show time.

Through beginner-focused classes offered at Arabian horse shows, the Academy division helps riders, instructors, and shows grow our community together — laying the foundation for lifelong involvement with the Arabian horse.

Rider Eligibility

1. This program is designed for beginner riders in their first 1 to 2 years of showing who are Novice riders as defined by USEF. This program is NOT designed for experienced riders or showers, please be respectful of the spirit and intent of the program.
2. Novice rider is defined as a rider who has not won more than three (3) 1st place ribbons/finishes in a rated show as of the beginning of the current show season. *Single horse classes do not count towards novice rider status.*
3. UAHC Academy Program Riders must be members of the Utah Arabian Horse Club (UAHC — AHA Club #7014). Fill out your UAHC Membership Application with your entry form or mail in prior to the first show of the year.
4. Any issues regarding rider or horse eligibility or protests will be decided by the Academy show committee.

Horses

5. Any breed of horse is allowed. Grade horses are welcome. Registration is not required. Horses must be suitable to the Academy division, displaying good manners and a quiet disposition.
6. Riders and horses are not required to be enrolled in a professionally operated lesson program, though participation in one is encouraged.
7. Horses are not required to be owned by the exhibitor.
8. Show grooming/clipping/braiding is not required, but a neat, clean, well-turned-out horse is strongly encouraged.
9. When horses are presented “Hunter” style in English (All Seats) classes, braiding is allowed but not required.
10. Horses of any age may be shown in a bosal (western) or snaffle bit without penalty. Two-handed riding in western classes is permitted only with horses in a bosal or snaffle bit.



11. Horses may be shared by riders in different age divisions. Horses and riders may cross-enter in Academy type class and rated classes within the same show, but riders may not cross-enter between the Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter class divisions (rated or Academy).
12. Any horse or rider deemed unsafe or not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by horse show management or the judge.

Attire Specifications

13. Riding saddle seat suits, hunt coats, and western chaps are **NOT allowed**.
14. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches, or colored jeans are considered appropriate.
15. A neatly fitted long sleeve shirt or top is strongly suggested.
16. A riding helmet is **MANDATORY** for riders 18 years of age and under, and strongly suggested for all ages. Helmets must be ASTM/SEI or USEF approved.
17. Appropriate footwear with a small heel is **MANDATORY**.
18. Attire and tack should be clean, safe, and well appointed. Excessive bling is discouraged and will not be advantageous in placings.

Tack Specifications

19. Tack must be conservatively colored (brown or black) and in good repair.
20. Black or brown nylon or synthetic tack may be used.
21. A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used.
22. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed. Martingales are permitted and encouraged. Tie-down martingales are NOT allowed.
23. Show tack is allowed but not encouraged and will not be advantageous in judging.
24. Whips may be carried in Showmanship and Hunter disciplines but must be of legal length according to USEF rules. Whips may not be carried in Western classes.
25. English classes — riders and tack for horses may be Hunt Seat or Saddle Seat and will be judged accordingly.

Class Specifications

26. These are not AHA or USEF sanctioned classes. Entries must follow written show premium rules.
27. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage, and upon the riding skills of the rider.
28. Equitation classes (on the rail, no pattern) are judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times. Riders should convey good posture, hand placement, leg placement, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. Riders should be able to identify correct diagonals.

29. Pleasure classes differ from Equitation in that they are judged more on the rider's ability to display their horse to its best advantage, communicating through horsemanship and riding abilities that the horse is a pleasure to ride. Riders should be able to identify leads promptly and control their horse's rate in a consistent manner.
30. Showmanship classes are judged on the handler's basic horsemanship skills. The horse itself is not judged on conformation. Rather, the exhibitor is judged on how well he or she presents the animal to its best advantage, with additional scoring for the grooming and presentation of both horse and handler.
 - a. The pattern exhibitors are to perform will be posted Wednesday evening. It must be memorized; riders may not carry notes or be coached while in the ring. Horses will all enter the ring, line up first, then work the pattern individually.
 - b. An exhibitor is not allowed to touch the horse during the pattern and set up. Each part of the pattern should be treated as a separate task, leaving maneuvers crisp rather than sloppy and run together. Exhibitors should appear confident and happy, ultimately selling themselves and their horse to the judge.
 - c. The "quarter system" will be used when presenting the horse to the judge.
 - d. The judge may ask the exhibitor questions about the parts of the horse, horse management, the age and breed of their animal, and so on. Exhibitors are expected to provide correct answers in a polite, confident, and professional manner.
31. All entries will be placed. Points are awarded based on the number of horses in the class (e.g., 6 horses in class: 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, etc.).
32. Headers are allowed in the lineup in all Walk/Trot classes.
33. The hand gallop is not to be asked for in any class.
34. If a rider needs to walk the class for safety reasons, that is acceptable and the rider should not be excused, but they will be judged accordingly to maintain fairness and integrity for all competitors.
35. One time-out per exhibitor is allowed per class. If more than one time-out is requested, the horse may be excused from the ring or disqualified. The entrant will not receive points but will still receive credit for participating in the class.
36. In equitation, riders who are unseated may be disqualified at the discretion of the judge.
37. Classes may be split at the discretion of show management.
38. Classes will be judged by USEF guidelines.

High Point & Awards

42. High point awards will be run in accordance with the UAHC 2026 High Point Rules.
43. Points are awarded based on the number of horses in the class (e.g., 6 horses: 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, etc.). Tie breaker is determined by overall number of highest placings (most 1sts, then most 2nds, etc.).

44. Enter complete name, address, and zip code of Owner/Trainer/Rider on the Academy Entry Form.
45. Mandatory signatures of Owner/Agent/Rider/Trainer/Coach are required on the form. All riders must sign the entry form. Youth cannot sign the entry form — Parents/Agent/Trainer must sign for youth exhibitors.
46. Permission of Minors to show signature is mandatory on the back of the entry form (if applicable).
47. Fill out UAHC membership application at the show or mail in with your entry form prior to the first show.
