## Advent Wreath Making this Sunday, December 2nd at 9:45-10:45, (between 9:00 am and 11:00 am services).

**Advent** is the period of four Sundays/weeks before Christmas. We Christians use this time to prepare and remember the real meaning of Christmas.

The Advent wreath is shaped in a perfect circle to symbolize the eternity of God. Set on the branches of the wreath are four candles: three **purple** and one **pink**. In the center of the wreath sits a white candle. As a whole, these candles represent the coming of the light of Christ into the world. During each Sunday of the Advent season, we light another candle and focus on the four virtues Jesus brings us: **Hope, Love, Joy and Peace**. The Christ candle (center white candle) is lit on Christmas Eve reminding us that Jesus is the light of the world. The wreath continually reminds us to keep Christ at the center of Christmas.

Join us between the 9 am and 11 am services down in the fellowship hall. Bring your Advent plate and candle holder (if you have one from prior years)...We will have extras if you don't have one. All other supplies and candles will be on hand.

Coffee and donuts will be available.
