We enter April through Holy Week this year. Holy Week or Passion Week is when we collectively remember and participate in the story of Jesus' final days leading up to the crucifixion on Good Friday and then the Joy of Easter morn. The events we celebrate this coming week are central to the Christian faith. The Last Supper, the teachings to love one another, the death and betrayal, and finally, the grief that gives way to joy and new life are just some of the features of Holy Week. This story of Jesus is the central memory of the people who became the church. Even if we weren't there, we all participate in these events when we participate in the life of Christ.

If I had to sum up the significance of this time, I would have to borrow a word from my favorite author, J.R.R. Tolkien. Tolkien was the writer of the *Hobbit* and the *Lord of the Rings* as well as other scholarly works. He coined a word that describes the situation when something goes from Bad to Good, "eucatastrophe." He coined this word in his book *On Fairy Stories* and in one of his letters. And while he was talking of this for fiction, we should know that he was a devout Christian and almost couldn't avoid using the language of Grace and Resurrection. Eucatastrophe is a word made by putting Evangelium (Greek for Good news) with Catastrophe (a sudden unexpected turn). Only this turn of events is so profoundly good that it transforms us.

The Passion and Easter are about the sudden grace-filled turn from evil and pain to something Good and joy-filled. It's about God's insistence that things will not turn out as the world expects. Instead, God will turn death and cruelty upside down to create life and Goodness.

What more can I say about this time of year and what we celebrate? Remember the Joy of Jesus this month and all year round. A joy that says things will turn out how God intends, no matter the cost. Grace will find a way to surprise you with Joy.
