In August we continue to look at THE RIGHTEOUS REIGN OF GOD, this time through the eyes of the apostle Paul, whose teachings reveal the kingdom-living behavior required for believers. Such behavior is summarized in the command to love others and live a life filled with certain spiritual fruit. Rather than tearing others down, living in light of God's kingdom calls believers to build up other believers.

Paul's letter to believers in Corinth reveals his deep concern regarding the seriousness of the kingdom. The Corinthians were reminded that the Lord, the King, would be the final judge regarding their behavior. Arrogance would have no place

in God's kingdom.

Finally, Paul taught that the future bodily resurrection of believers would usher in the fulfillment of God's kingdom plans. At the return of Christ to earth and the moment of the promised resurrection of believers, Jesus will hand over the kingdom to God the Father. God's kingdom will reign in totality, without opposition. Only the Lord God who is omnipotent will reign and citizens of his kingdom will joyfully enter into his presence in worship.


