The Story of Christian Symbols told by Taylorsville UMC Stained Glass Windows Window Ten – The Lily


Inset of Lily Window

As I mentioned last month, the selection of stained-glass windows is getting smaller and smaller. So relating them to a Christian season, which I would normally do, is not going to happen with the Lily symbols. Traditionally, the Lily symbolizes the resurrection of Christ and is prominent around Easter, as it is a Spring blooming flower. It is recognized that the bulb decays in the

ground, yet from it, new life is released, thus the sign of immortality. Due to the Lily being related to Easter, it is often shown with the symbol of the cross. Although, there are many varieties of lilies which bloom throughout the growing season, it is only the white Easter Lily, a sign of purity, that is associated with Christ.



However, like several of the Christian symbols I have researched for these newsletter articles, the Lily represents many other Christian related people and attributes. Apparently, many of the saints, or at least their followers, liked the lily symbol. It is the symbol associated with the annunciation of the Virgin Mary, so the lily shows up in her symbol as well as the symbol of Saint Gabriel, who came to her and ironically, also in the symbol for Saint Joseph. All associated with the birth of Jesus, not his death. (Interesting fact!)



Having been talking about a season of growth this summer, I guess a flower which is a sign of rebirth, representing our Lord and Savior is an appropriate window after all. *Pastor Patty*






