The Story of Christian Symbols told by Taylorsville UMC Stained Glass Windows

Window Four - Wheat Sheaf and Wheat Sickle

February represents two very important days in 2021 and both are associated with Christianity. St. Valentine's Day, February 14, which is the day we share our love for those special in our lives, whether family, friend or our Father. Ash Wednesday also falls in February in 2021, on February 17, and represents the beginning of Lent, as well as a day of prayer and fasting.

I struggled a bit trying to find a symbol from our stained-glass windows

I struggled a bit trying to find a symbol from our stained-glass windows that represented these special days and was surprised to find the wheat symbol was appropriate for both. The significance of the wheat symbol has many definitions, but the one I found at the top of the list was Love and Charity. A single sheaf of wheat also represents harvest and fertility. Wheat images are seen in two of our windows, one of which includes the sickle.

I am so impressed with the thinking of our predecessors when deciding on the images for the windows.

The Wheat and Sickle symbol has been associated with the harvesting of souls for God, but has been corrupted in some interpretations as being the opposite, with death being represented as a hooded figure carrying a sickle.

I had to include this picture because it represents one of the most beautiful love stories in the Bible, Ruth and Boaz – the gleaning of the wheat was a gesture made by field owners to help with the support for the poor. They would glean the field of left-over harvest to feed their families – ergo the meaning of Love and Charity.



The service will begin at 7:00 p.m. for those who wish to participate within the community of faith.




