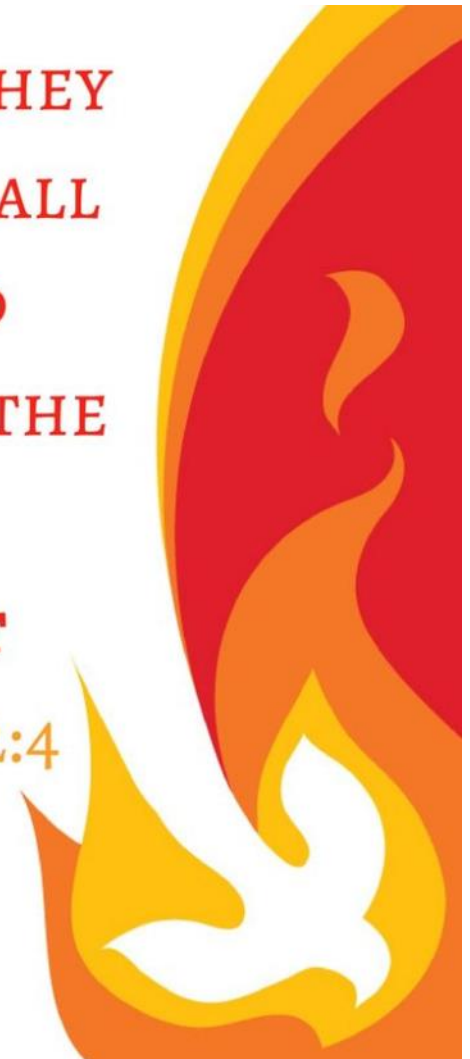

Our summer series of lessons entitled **Partners In A New Creation** begins in June as we look at a future described by Isaiah. The prophet Isaiah lived through the Assyrian crisis, having begun his prophetic ministry in about 740 BC in Jerusalem. He foresaw the coming oppression by Babylon as a time when the land of Israel would be largely emptied of its people. Even so, he offered hope for a future time when “the Lord comforts his people and will have compassion on his afflicted ones” (Isaiah 49:13). This was a promise to the faithful of Israel, for “those who hope in me will not be disappointed” (Isaiah 49:23).

Isaiah also saw a future that would involve more than a restoration of peace. He spoke of the final restoration of humanity, when “[the Lord] will make her deserts like Eden, her wastelands like the garden of the Lord” (Isaiah 51:3). That restoration will ultimately come through Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God.

Vacation Bible Camp News:

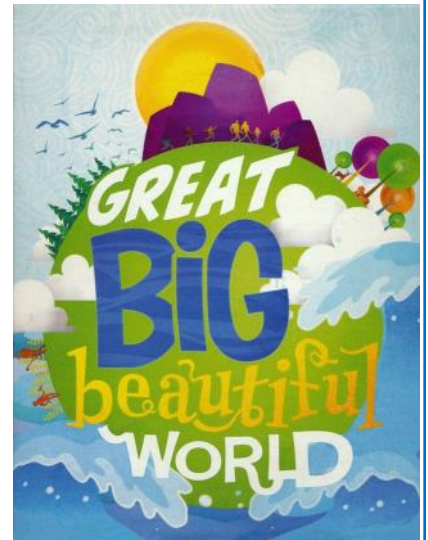
We have had several meetings to plan this community outreach for July 25 - 28th.
