Blessings Dear TUMC Family,

Communication. This is something that every church deals with. Misunderstandings can be avoided, and great things can be accomplished where there is open communication. How do we effectively communicate the work, needs, and missions of the church to the people of the church?

Communication specialists estimate that it takes communicating a message at least sixteen times for the information to spread throughout an organization. I laughed when I read that statistic because I thought... "They have never been in church. Tell the right person and EVERYONE will know."

Here at Taylorsville UMC we are constantly seeking ways to improve our communication. One of the ways we have improved communication in my four years as pastor of TUMC is the Taylorsville Tidbits. The weekly newsletter allows us an opportunity to share the news and events of the week. Anna does an amazing job putting the Tidbits together. We want to include pictures every week of the ministries of TUMC, UMW, UMM, Sunday School, JOY, etc... so, take pictures and send them to Anna. You will make her day if you do!

Another way we communicate is through this newsletter. Each committee or ministry is asked to provide a paragraph or two about what their committee is doing. Unfortunately, we don't always hear from each committee or ministry and cannot share it with the congregation. Beginning in September we will be sharing the minutes from the Council in our newsletter. At each Council meeting every ministry is represented and gives a short report of what is happening in their ministry. Hopefully by including the Council minutes we can improve the communication at TUMC.

Another area we need to improve in communication is between pastor and congregation. I will admit that I am not always plugged into my phone, so I may miss texts, emails, and phone calls. I do not follow anyone on Facebook, Twitter or Instagram. My phone is a tool not my god. So, please do not get offended if I do not respond to your text or email within minutes. However, I will strive to do better in the future when it comes to answering emails and texts.

One way I hope we can improve in our communication is letting me and the prayer team know when someone is in need. Something pastors say is "Mind reading was not a class in seminary." I only know what is shared with me. Please let me know how I can pray for you. Let me know what is going on with you. It is a privilege and honor to pray for the people God has called me to serve. Our prayer team feels the same way. If you have a prayer concern, the prayer team is ready to pray. Each prayer concern is held in confidence and only shared with the congregation with permission.

Communication. It is a process in which information is exchanged between individuals. If we are going to improve communication at Taylorsville UMC we need to work together in sharing information. Our words are a reflection of what is in our hearts, so we should constantly be filling our hearts and minds with what is best. The apostle Paul encourages us in this way, "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things" ([Philippians 4:8](#)). If we follow God's word, then our communication and relationships with others will not only improve, but we will have favor and be blessed.







**Recipe for Lemon Delight ~ submitted by:

**Ingredients:**

- 1 C flour
- 1 stick butter
- 3/4 C chopped walnuts
- 2 (4 oz.) pkgs. instant lemon pudding/pie filling
- 3 C milk
- 8oz. Cream cheese
- 1 C 10x sugar
- 16 oz. Cool Whip

**Crust:** 1 C flour, stick of butter, 1/2 c chopped walnuts. Cream together and press into 13X9 baking dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 -20 minutes. Allow to cool.

**2nd layer:** 8 oz cream cheese, 1 C 10X sugar, 1 cup cool whip. Mix and spread over crust.

**3rd layer:** 2 pkgs lemon instant pudding, 3 C milk. Whisk together and pour over 2nd layer.

Spread remaining cool whip over pudding. Garnish with remaining chopped walnuts if desired.


On June 22 the UMW went on a field trip to **Therapeutic Recreational Riding Center** 3750 Shady Lane, Glenwood, MD. We met with Lynn Moorhead who is the volunteer coordinator at TRRC. She spoke to us about the mission of TRRC and the need for volunteers to help with the care of the horses and to assist with the therapeutic riding lessons. We took a tour of the facility and met with Dr. Helen Tuel. Dr. Tuel is the founding director. She spoke about how thirty years ago she realized that there were no therapeutic riding centers in the area and she saw a need for therapeutic riding lessons for special needs children and adults. She and her husband John began TRRC and it has grown to a 55 acre farm with almost 30 horses and ponies.

On June 1, TRRC hosted the Howard County Special Olympics equestrian team competition. It was a beautiful day on the farm. There were 30 athletes participating. Thank you UMW for putting hanging baskets together to decorate TRRC for the Special Olympics.
