One point of conflict in the first-century church concerned the authority and relevancy of the Law of Moses. During the fall quarter we will explore the relationship between faith and law through Jesus' teachings and writings to the first-century church.

During his earthly ministry Jesus experienced conflict with certain Pharisees. This party of Judaism was strict and passionate regarding obedience to the Law of Moses. To ensure obedience they had established traditions to guide their actions.

However, Jesus identified disparities between the requirements of the Law and the Pharisees' obedience. One inconsistency involved their devotion to the law at the expense of acting with love. Others regarded their observance of the Sabbath and disregard for God's requirements for justice and mercy.


