

## Organizational Meeting Minutes

An organizational meeting was held at the Black Forest Restaurant, Frankenmuth, Michigan at 10:30 A.M. on Saturday, February 24, 2001 to explore the possibility of starting a new chapter of the Studebaker Drivers Club.
