## AROUND THE CLUB




Noarlunga members showed up in numbers at the Maitland Open and shot some really good scores.

#### FROM OUR CAPTAIN

Following a recent review of safety and procedural processes of the club facilities and member behaviours, it is suggested that when two or more shooters are shooting a match for practice,1 person must be identified as Range Officer before commencing.

Ideally an RO should not be shooting and remain behind the shooting line at all times at all times to ensure safety protocols are being observed correctly.

If an RO is shooting the match also it is suggested that another shooter may score their target or replace the target between rounds so that it may be scored later allowing the RO to remain in a suitable position to observe.

If less than 3 shooters the door should be locked before moving forward if guns are left on the benches.

### **CLEAN UP!**

After shooting matches or practice members are reminded that they must clean up their brass after completion (all brass and casings). Not only is the a courtesy to other shooters who should not have to clean up after the last shooters, this is vital to ensure we are not leaving live rounds on the Range. We are all aware this is a breach of the firearms act and it will be unfair on all members if the club were to be fined because 1 or 2 people were to lazy to clean up after themselves.

#### AMMUNITION RESRICTIONS

There has been evidence found that members are using the incorrect ammunition on the range. Examples:

Only 12 Gauge 7 1/2 shot shotgun shell can be used.

No Jacketed ammunition.

Be careful when purchasing ammunition that can be used at our club.

If in doubt talk to a committee member or speak to the Captain or Armorer.

# SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

The club now has a liquor licence and a selection of beer and spirit mixers is available for sale and consumption on the premises

## Please note

- You can only purchase and consume alcohol once you have finished shooting for the day
- Once you have consumed any alcohol, you may not shoot or officiate in any capacity on range
- Alcohol cannot be taken on to any range (as per signage at the entrance to each range)
- Alcohol can ONLY be accessed / served by an approved RSA (no RSA on site = no alcohol available)
- Initially we are focusing on Sundays and Wednesdays with a view to extending to Tuesdays and Saturdays as RSA trained members become available.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE BELOW ADVICE AT ALL TIMES ON THE RANGE AND PACK UP IF YOU ARE THE LAST SHOOTER ON THE RANGE (FLAGS, COMPRESSOR, POWER ECT.)



# RANGE ETIQUETTE & HOUSE-KEEPING

- Please be on range at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time as a courtesy to your fellow club members who have set up and are ready to start shooting at the scheduled time
- The Range Officer has total control of the range and the match follow all Range Officer commands without exception
- On match completion, sweep up your spent brass and evaluate your used target:
  - If reusable patch it before returning it to the target storage unit for re-use
  - If shot-out dispose in one of the yellow lidded wheelie bins near the clubhouse
  - If in doubt, ask!

(The above also applies for practice sessions – please patch targets before storing for re-use)

- Assist with taking range caddies and target carriers back to the clubhouse
- Leave the range clean and tidy for the next user(s)
