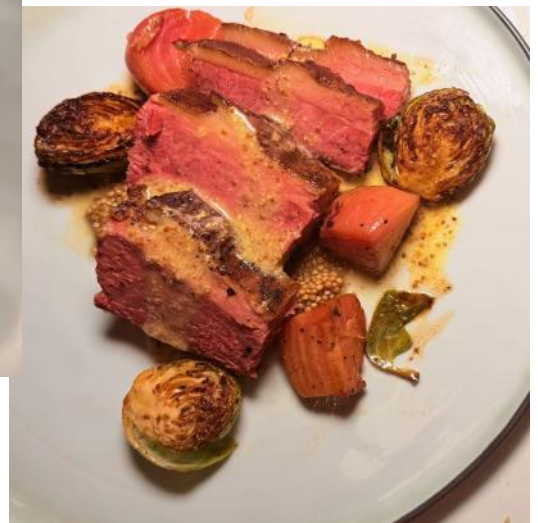


He did beat Bobby with his signature Matzoh Ball soup, inspired by his grandmother, which we will have the privilege to enjoy as one of our choices.

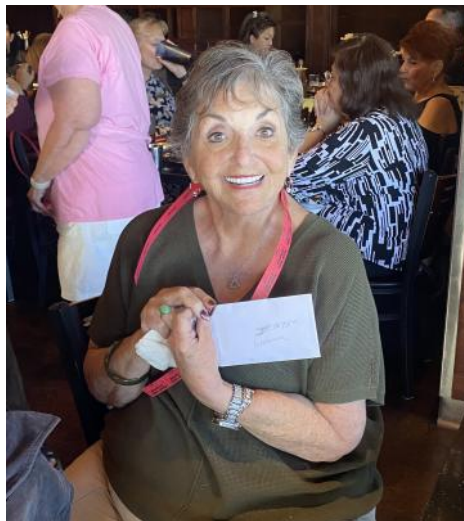

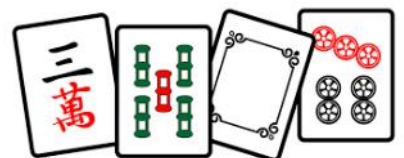
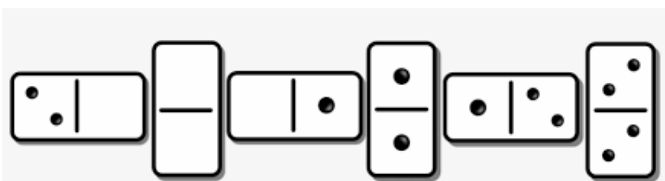
