

FURTHER NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (TURVEY ROAD (PART), ASTWOOD) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2020

FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in relation to a temporary prohibition of vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along part of Turvey Road, Astwood whilst essential works are carried out to install BT poles and overhead cabling. The restrictions were brought into effect under the provisions of the above-named Order, which was made by the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes on **23rd June 2020** under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as first notified on **18th June 2020**.

TAKE NOTICE that it is necessary to close that part of Turvey Road in order to install BT poles and overhead cabling.

The temporary closure will come into effect on 21st September 2020 and will remain in effect until 25th September 2020. The closure will only be in effect during the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm each day.

The above roads are scheduled to be closed during the periods stated above and **only** when works are to be carried out and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

Whilst the above closure is in effect, the alternative route will be via Newport Road (A422), A428, Newton Lane (to Newton Blossomville), Hardmead Lane and Turvey Road (and vice versa). The alternative route will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Signs Manual.

Access will be maintained for emergency services throughout the closure. All other provisions of the Order remain as previously notified on **18th June 2020**.
