

Rules of Tournament

- 5 field player vs 5 field players with 1 goalie each (6v6)
- No slide tackling
- Shots must be taken inside shooting zone
- No long goal-kicks, must pass to player in their own half before advancing to the second half
- No more than 10 players on a roster
- 3 Points for a Win, 1 Point for a tie, 0 Points for a loss
- If teams are tied, tie-breaker will be head to head, proceeded by goal differential, proceeded by penalty shoot-out
- Semi-Final/ Final: If tied, 10-minute extra time will be held. If still tied, penalty shootout will be held to see what team advances to next round or wins match
- A red card results in one match ban for the player depending on the foul/ challenge. Will be referees discretion; Minimum 1 game
- For Rec Division is Round-Robin Structured

Participant Liability Release Form

Participants are required to fill out release form (online or at registration check-in), this form is designed to provide SoccerFest with limited protections from legal actions. With signage of this form, participants and guardians are aware of the danger and risk involved with SoccerFest. Participants that are under the age of 18 years old must have a parent or legal guardian sign wavier on their behalf.

SoccerFest Sportsmanship Code

Participants and spectators in SoccerFest 2023 are expected and required to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. Spectators will be encouraged to cheer for their team/athletes, and players will be encouraged to support each other. However, any extreme heckling or profane language used against players or other fans will not be tolerated. Disputes with calls will not be tolerated by referees, and any argument or debate with them which turns out uncivilized will result in the offending party being sent home from the tournament. If a team cannot be humble in their victory and/or gracious in defeat, they may be disqualified. Fighting will not be allowed and any members who are involved in a physical confrontation will be escorted off the premises. Finally, any damage done to tournament equipment and/or facilities due to unsportsmanlike tantrums will be the full financial liability of the offending party and the individual will not be allowed to remain at the tournament facility.
