The Riverside School is a Local Authority school for pupils with special needs aged 4-19. The disabilities of the majority of children are such that they require one to one supervision and although the salaries of the staff are met by the Local authority the school desperately needs financial assistance to provide extra equipment to improve the children's education and quality of life. We were shown around the school by the Headmaster Steve Solomons and met a number of the pupils and the amazing staff. The centre started with one physiotherapist but has increased to two physiotherapists and two therapy assistants. It continues to help scores of severely disabled children with physiotherapy. **The Captain presented Dan Catchesides with a cheque for £1,500.00. Freddie Farmer was also at the presentation.**
