

Sowing and Reaping Bountifully

The New Testament refers to Giving as Sowing (Seed.)

*Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for **WHATEVER** a man sows, that he will also reap. (Galatians 6:7 NKJV)*

We saw in the last lesson that not only will we reap WHAT we sow we will reap MORE THAN we sow, and in the increments (measure) that we sow and even up to 100-Fold (10,000%..ROI) (Luke 6:38, Mark 10:28-30)

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. (2 Corinthians 9:6 NKJV) (the entire chapter is about a financial offering.)

How can we recognize (define) “Bountiful Sowing?”

*Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and saw **HOW** the people put money into the treasury. And many who were rich **PUT IN MUCH**. ⁴²Then one poor widow came and **THREW** in two mites, which make a quadrans. ⁴³So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in **MORE THAN ALL** those who have given to the treasury; ⁴⁴for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in **ALL THAT SHE HAD, HER WHOLE LIVELIHOOD**.” (Mark 12:41-44 NKJV)*

Jesus set this poor widow as the example of Bountiful Sowing for all future generations.

Can (should) poor people participate in giving and receiving (sowing and reaping?)

Who sowed bountifully?

The Rich who put in much, but kept much more?

OR...the one who put in what appeared to be an insignificant amount, but put in ALL...Her entire living?

It's clear that bountiful sowing is a **Percentage (%)** not an **Amount (\$\$.)**

So bountiful sowing is determined by the amount we keep not the amount we give.

How do you know that you REALLY believe these scriptures, principles, and promises?
