



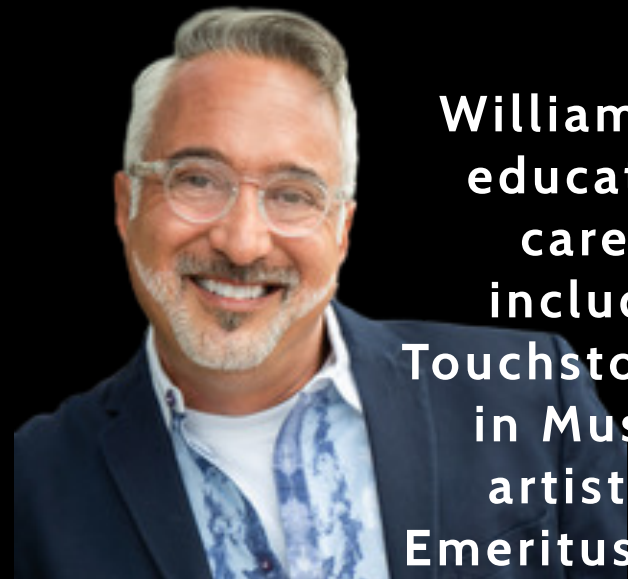
SABRINA HARPER
