

Lake of the Pines Amenities & Lifestyle Guide 🌲

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Location Overview

Lake of the Pines (LOP) is a **private**, **gated community** nestled between Auburn and Grass Valley at roughly 1,500 ft elevation. With approximately 6,700 residents and 2,050 developed lots, the neighborhood offers a peaceful yet active lifestyle with a strong mix of working families and retirees.

- Lot sizes range from ¼ to 6.5 acres (avg: ⅓ acre)
- Primarily single-family homes with 23 duplexes
- 24-hour gate security and patrol services
- Managed by the Lake of the Pines HOA

- Lake temperatures reach 75°F+ in summer
- 🚣 Water activities include: kayaking, paddleboarding, fishing, sailing, water skiing
- Boat registration required (based on size/horsepower)
- Storage racks for paddleboards and kayaks at designated parks

Fishing

LOP waters are stocked and home to:

- Trout
- Largemouth & smallmouth bass
- Bluegill, red ear, sunfish, black crappie, catfish

Fishing is allowed from boats, specified shoreline areas, and ponds.

👗 Golf

- 19-hole course with alternate 9th hole, totaling 6,140 yards
- Paved golf cart paths throughout
- Open to LOP members and their guests

- LOP Resident: \$45 (18 holes) / \$30 (9 holes)
- Resident Guests: \$55 / \$35
- Cart Rentals: \$20 (18 holes), \$10 (9 holes)
- Triving Range: \$5 (small bucket), \$10 (large bucket)
- Annual Membership: \$1,795 (individual)

M Parks

LOP features 6 developed parks with:

- Name of the Playgrounds
- Sports courts
- Dog park with a private pond
- Most parks include restrooms

Sports Courts

- 2 4 Tennis courts (gate card access; reservable)
- Pickleball courts (Hazel Park; equipment provided)
- Sand volleyball & basketball (Hazel Park)

Swimming Pools

- Junior Olympic-size pool + kiddie pool
- Seasonal access (spring through fall)
- Activities include swim lessons, lap swim, and water aerobics

% Wildlife

LOP is home to deer, otters, muskrats, turtles, snakes, egrets, osprey, and bald eagles — offering daily nature encounters alongside lakeside living.

- Hospitals: Sutter Auburn Faith (under 10 mi), Sierra Nevada Dignity Health (15 mi), Kaiser in Roseville (25 mi) & Sacramento (36 mi)
- Urgent care clinics within 10 mi
- Nearby dentists, optometrists, and primary care providers

- Y Generations Gym (1 mi from gate)
- Auburn Racquet Club & CAC Fitness (in Auburn)

Utilities & Services

- Electricity: PG&E
- degree Gas: Propane (local vendors typically Suburban Propane)
- Mater: Nevada Irrigation District

- Trash: Waste Management (weekly pickup incl. yard waste & recycling)
- Internet: provided by Suddenlink and paid by the HOA
- Sewage: Nevada County Sanitation (assessed annually though property taxes)
- Telephone: Pacific Telephone service at all lots
- Mail: On-site mailboxes or PO boxes available
