About the Historical Society & History Center

Mission

The Old Colorado City Historical Society, a 501(c)3 is a non-profit volunteer organization established to recognize the historical significance and unique culture of the original Colorado City and early El Paso County, which Includes the present and future history of today's greater Westside neighborhood.

The organization perpetuates the preservation and display of artifacts and archival materials, encourages research, education of children and the community, through the membership and the operation of the Old Colorado City History Center at 1 S. 24^{th} St., Colorado Springs, CO. 80904.

History

The First Baptist Church of Colorado City, built in 1890, now is the home of the Old Colorado City History Center. Constructed on land donated to the church by early pioneer Jane Root Quinby, the building was listed on the Colorado Register of Historic Places in 1995, not only for its age, but also for the prominence of its architect, Walter F. Douglas. Listed in a Colorado Springs directory in 1886, Douglas built several buildings, homes and churches in Colorado Springs. The Old Colorado City Historical Society purchased the building in 1992 to be used as a museum and history center. The Society, organized in 1980, has the mission of keeping the memories of Colorado City alive, encourage research and celebrate the unique spirit of the old west side today.

Special Events Descriptions

Victorian Tea – Help host a High Tea at the History Center

Auction – Help run an online/in person auction of items from collections and donations. (Fundraising event)

Territory Days – Work in the Garvin Cabin in Bancroft Park or the History Center giving short history snippets to guests.

Silhouette Portraits at Territory Days –At Garvin Cabin work with guests to compose a Victorian Era Silhouette Portrait that they can take with them.

Tunnel Tales Walking Tour – Discuss the Tunnels that run throughout Colo City, either as a tour guide or as an enactor at the different stops along the tour. (1-day tour)

Walk on the Wild Side Walking Tour – Discuss the Red-Light district and the wilder parts of Colo City, either as a tour guide or as an enactor at different stops along tour. (1-day tour)

Haunted Histories Fairview Cemetery Crawl – Ghost Host: lead guests on timed tour(s) around Fairview cemetery, telling different stories about Victorian Colo City. OR be a Colorado City Citizen Ghost who stands at or near their grave site and tells a short story about their life and demise. (1 or 2 nights/days)

Odd & Eerie Walking Tour – on Friday nights and Saturdays throughout October, led tours around Colo City:

Come and explore the darker side of Colorado City's past, filled with chilling deaths, strange happenings, and paranormal mischief. Our guides will unearth stories of spooky tunnels and strange tragedies in this hour-long walking tour of the OCC Historic District.

Becoming a Volunteer

- Complete the volunteer application and misc. forms required for their position.
- Meet with a Board Member to assess volunteer interests and proper placement.
- Participate in a New Volunteer Orientation.
- Participate in any training for desired position(s).
- Record their volunteer hours in the Volunteer Time Record Binder
