The Twin City Area Optimist Club awards ribbons and gift cards to the Best of Show, first, second and third place winners in each age category (see judging criteria enclosure) as well as Judge's Choice and Honorable Mention ribbons. All students entering receive a Certificate of Participation. All students attending on November 24 receive attendance prizes (art supplies).

The contest is open to the students as well as the public for viewing all exhibits. Art supplies are given as attendance prizes to students attending the contest.

Please encourage your students to enter. In 2023 we had more than 322 entries from participating schools. If you choose not to participate as a school project, please offer the application form to individual students who might like to enter the contest on their own. Please note the days, times and location to drop-off and register entries. Please feel free to make copies of the application form (one needs to be attached to each entry) as needed.
