

#### OPTIMIST DISTRICT COMPETITIONS

Optimist Club Oratorical Contest Winners will compete at the Optimist District Contest for a chance to win up to a **\$2,500** scholarship. Scholarship must be redeemed by the age of 25.

#### OPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL ORATORICAL REGIONAL COMPETITIONS

One Optimist District Winner will compete at the Optimist Regional Contest at Saint Louis University in St. Louis, Missouri. The Regional Scholarship award is **\$5,000**. Scholarship must be redeemed by the age of 25. The Regional Contest will be held **July 20-22, 2022**, at Saint Louis University.

#### OPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL ORATORICAL WORLD COMPETITIONS

Each Regional Winner will compete in the World Championship Contest for a chance to win a first, second, or third place scholarship of **\$15,000**, **\$10,000**, or **\$5,000** respectively. The World Championship Contest will be held **July 20-22, 2022**, at Saint Louis University.
