

The Twin City Area Optimist Club Art Contest took place on Sunday, November 5, 2023 at Elks Lodge 1721 in Festus. The annual event had 322 entries with 215 student artists exhibiting artwork. The students and their art were represented by the following schools in southern Jefferson County: Festus High School, De Soto High School, De Soto Junior High School, Herculaneum High School, Senn-Thomas Middle School, Hillsboro High School, Hillsboro Junior High School, Crystal City High School, Danby-Rush Tower (R-7) Middle School, St. Pius X High School and Jefferson R-VII. Three entries were submitted by homeschooled students. Entries were showcased in art categories, photography, three-dimensional and graphic/digital art.

Best of Show winner was Sailor Tucker, Herculaneum High School with his entry "Untitled." 





with Optimism"


The Essay Contest is sponsored by Optimist International to give young people the opportunity to write about their own opinions regarding the world in which they live.
