Meet New Optimist International Director Cheryl Brenn (January 13, 2022)



Our club is very fortunate to be the first club new Optimist International (OI) Director Cheryl Brenn has visited since taking over leadership of OI. She is not only the first woman at the head of OI, but also the first woman to lead any of the four international service organizations (Kiwanis, Lions, Rotary, and Optimists).

Cheryl talked about how women have a different approach to leadership and now was the time for change. She spoke of empowering women. All service organizations have been losing members and changes are needed to succeed going forward.

She referred to the pandemic and how schools have dropped programs because funds were needed to address COVID. It is up to us, as Optimists, to step in by continuing to bring out the best in kids.

Cheryl said that as women we tend to support others before ourselves. She said to remember that when in an airplane we are asked to put on our masks first so that we can then help others. We need to address our own needs before we can be of service to others.

With soft music, we took a few minutes to meditate as Cheryl read the Optimist Creed. By quietly listening and her accents on certain words, made us all feel differently and empowered by our creed.

Nurses for Newborns exists to provide a safety net for families most at-risk. In order to prevent infant mortality, child abuse, and neglect the agency provides in-home nursing visits which promotes healthcare, education and positive parenting skills.

Referrals for services come from hospitals, physicians, social workers, as well as 20% self-referred. The agency works with all income levels. Clients may include mothers with mental, substance abuse, or abusive relationship issues.

Services are provided up to two years after birth and help to address safety and wellness concerns.

Optimist Day February 3, 2022










Twin City Area Optimist Essay Contest
