We are well into the latter half of this fiscal year. In the next few months, President Elect Phyllis Neff will begin preparing a budget for the next year, asking for members to chair committees, and host board meetings. Please keep your hearts and minds open to serving as a chair or volunteering on a committee.



Thanks to the success of fundraisers and the Marketing Committees effort to obtain sponsorships, the club's treasury is financially sound. Our club was also once again awarded a grant in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the Jefferson Foundation for the Coats for Kids / HeadStart winter wear. These efforts help to cover the cost of all projects without continually asking members for financial assistance outside of the fundraising events and frees up our club's money to fully fund other projects.

We have also done well in maintaining the level of membership in the club. One of the criteria for achieving Honor Club recognition is to end the year with 3+ members. Membership as of September 30, 2019, was 107. Current membership is at 113, but we still need to recruit a few more just in case. One of the criteria for being recognized as a Distinguished Club is to meet the criteria of Honor Club and add 15 members or start a new club. The board voted at the May meeting to co-sponsor the new Fenton / High Ridge Club. This should satisfy that requirement. Being recognized as a Honor Club or Distinguished Club is a tribute to all the hard work of our members.






Junior Optimists have a Talent Show for the Headstart at Hematite
