## Thank You!

Thank you to the recreation committee and community volunteers for a successful Community Day event this past August. It was a true success and fun for all ages!

A special shout out and thank you to all the PHVFD that helped in the chaos of the storm and for clean-up offer on the weekend of September 9th. Our thoughts and prayers are with any resident that have damage to their home and any injuries incurred.

The Patterson Heights Borough Council has had a successful summer, including a great Community Day in August. There were events for children and adults, snow cones, and great food prepared by the firemen and Ladies' Auxiliary. Community Day was organized and managed by Lindsey Beagle and her committee, including Councilman Ryan Errett, and committee member Helena Fields, as well as other members not mentioned here, for fear of forgetting someone. The Borough lived through a terrible storm on September 6th. Amazingly, there was only one serious injury that we are aware of, but many branches, and sometimes whole trees, came down resulting in property damage throughout the Borough. The cleanup is ongoing, creating great opportunities for landscapers.

Finally, you probably noticed the trucks from Insight Pipe here the past few weeks. Due to an American Rescue Plan federal grant obtained by the Council, Patterson Heights was able to use \$267,000 to reline almost all of our sanitary sewer system, much of which had been constructed of terra cotta, and was broken, crushed, or missing entirely. The Borough has now applied for and received more than \$400,000 in grants over the last three years, with much to show for the effort.

# Election Day

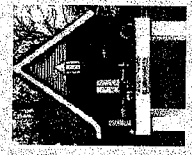
Tuesday, November 5, 2024, 7:00 AM-8:00 PM

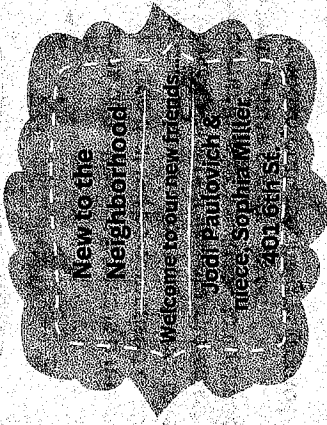
# A Message from the Fire Chief

On August 8, 2024, the Patterson Heights Volunteer Fire Department (PHVFD) reached a significant milestone by obtaining its Quick Response Service (QRS) certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH). This certification enables the department to provide rapid, life-saving medical assistance, further demonstrating PHVFD's commitment to serving the community.

Since becoming certified, the QRS program has become an invaluable asset to the residents of Patterson Heights and nearby areas. To date, we have responded to over 60 medical calls, delivering timely and effective care when it's needed most. This accomplishment not only showcases the dedication and training of PHVFD's members but also underscores the importance of having certified medical personnel available to support emergency services during critical situations.

PHVFD is proud of the progress its QRS program has made and remains committed to adapting to the evolving landscape of emergency services. As medical emergencies continue to change, the department is dedicated to staying ahead through ongoing training, equipment upgrades, and maintaining the highest standards of care and readiness.
