

- Ordinance No 2-

Prohibiting Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Swine, Geese, and other animals running at large.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

That from and after the fifteenth day of December A.D. 1899, it shall not be lawful for the owner or owners of any horse, cattle, sheep, swine, geese or other animal to permit the same to run at large within the limits of the Borough of Patterson Heights.

That it shall be the duty of the High-Coroner, Police Officer, Street Commissioner, or other person or persons as the Town Council may appoint for that purpose, to seize and take any such horse, cattle, sheep, swine, geese, or other animal that may be found running at large within the limits of the said Borough, and the sum of seventy-five cents shall be allowed such officer or other person for any seizure so made, to be paid by the owner or owners thereof, in addition to the fine and costs herein imposed.

That all horses, cattle, sheep, swine, geese or other animals so taken shall be placed in such or other place provided for their detention and there kept for forty-eight hours, and upon failure of the owner or owners thereof

to reclaim the pauper, within that time, and pay the fines herein<sup>above</sup> mentioned together with all the costs, the Street Commissioner shall sell the pauper at public outcry, after having given three days notice of the time and place of such sale by not less than two advertisements put up in the most public places in said borough.

That any owner or owners of any horses, cattle, sheep, swine, geese or other animal permitting the same to run at large within the limits of the borough as aforesaid shall upon conviction before the Burgess of said borough or any Justice of the Peace, forfeit and pay for the use of said borough, a fine of one dollar for the first offense; two dollars for each subsequent offense;
