Ordinance Do. 4.

Granting The Central District and Printing Telegraph Company the right to each and maintain boles, fifties, wind, cables, and supports, export, over, and along, the struct, highways, footwalks, have and alleys of the Dorough of Pattuson Artifalts Beaver Couldty, Demosphania, and the conditions herinafter provide Council of the Borough of Pattuson Heights, Country of Beaver, and State of Demosphania, and it is hearly or-

Selion 1. That the privilege be, and is hereby quarted to the Central Disc list and Drinting Telegrap he Combany, ils successors, and bessignes, to construct, oberate and maintain the mussain poles, fiftures, wins, cables and supports, in and upon the sheets, highways, footwalks, lanes and alleys If said borough as of konstructing, Specating and main laining links of telegraph and telephone Through the said brough to the place of business, works, manufacturing establishments, of fuces, and houses of subscribers, within the bowingh limits or udjacent thereto, Subject to The condelivous and regulations hereinafter contained.

Section &. That the said Central District and Printing Telegraph Company shall replace the streets highiodys, footwalks, lames and alleys of said borough upon which it shall erect any of its poles or fixtures as aforesaid, in as good condition as they were before said poles and fixtures were erected thereon; and further, that the location of said poles shall be made under the direction and supervision of the Street Committee, of the council of the borough aforesaid.

Section 3: That all poles erected under the provisions of this ordinance shall be reasonably straight, planted not less than five (5) feet in the ground, and shall be kept well painted by the said company, and there shall be no cross-arms for the suspension of wires and cables placed at a less distance than twenty (20) feet from the grade of the street, unless by permission of the said council.

Section 4: That whenever the said borough shall adopt a firealarm or police telegraph system, the said company shall permit the firealarm and police telegraph wires to run upon all the poles of the said
company, without charge, within the limits of the said borough, provided,
however, that such privilege shall not be so exercised as to interfere with
the proper use of said poles by said company. All such stringing or a
attaching of wires shall be done under the supervision of, and to the
satisfaction of said company. This privilege shall not be transferred or
sublet, except with the permission of said company.

Occion 5. It is further expussly understood and agreed that the Central District and Frinting Tel. egraph Company shall furnish for the use of said Borough of Patterso Heights, without change, our telephone to be located in such place with the limits of said borough as the Council may designate; the telephone to be used with the same sight and privilege as the other borough, but only for the leaus action of official borough business, and the said Central District an Quinting Telegraph Company shale so continue to funish for the us of the said Dorough of Patterson Heights, said telephone instrumens located as afousaid, until The said borough shall impose a li couse feel upon the poles or wires of sail company, when said sev-Iwice without Charge, shall cease. Section 6. The said company shall, within their (30) days before the passage and ab proval of this ordinance, file with the Olar of Council its certificate of surplance of all terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance. The said company shall pay all expenses incident to the passage and publication of the ordinance. Or part of ordinance of this ordinance, or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance, he, and the same is, hereby upealed, so far as the same affects this ordinance.
