

Notice of Election.

In accordance with ordinance No. 7, of which the foregoing is a true copy, notice is hereby given that an election will be held by the electors of the Borough of Paterson Heights at the usual place for holding elections in said Borough, on Tuesday, February, 17, 1903 between the hours of 7 o'clock A.M. and 7 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of obtaining the assent of said electors to, and their approval of, an increase of the funded indebtedness in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars; \$2000.00 and in order to give the information required by law, the following statement is declared;

The amount of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property of the Borough is \$105500.

The existing debt of the Borough is: Funded \$1300.00; Floating - none.

The indebtedness proposed is
\$5000.00 or 4.734 per cent of increase

Which will make a total
indebtedness of \$6,300.00 or 5.971 per cent
of the assessed valuation of taxable
property in said borough.

The purpose for which the
funded debt is to be increased, is
in making general permanent
improvements of streets.
