And in consideralion of said company fumish ing wich hydrauls, The said bolough shall pay for the same, at the rate of Forty-five dollars a few annum for each of said by dreats, payable quarticly on the first days of famous, Alpid, july and Actober of each year, dening the date of such levelent.

Section of It is also agued by The Italia Company That it will as of five as once a mouth, have a confect inspection of all five hydrauts used by The paids of the second part, and promptly repair the same when mecessary; and that if through accident or othinwise, any of such hydrauls shall remain out of order or The part of the fail

Section VI: And it is to be agreed that instead of a domestic or special rate herein above mentioned, consumers of water may use meters upon the following terms, to wit: The consumer may at his option, put in at his own expense an approved pattern of water meter, one of correct measurement, and where consumers exercise an option to use meters. The said company shall furnish them upon request, and upon the payment of the cost thereof to the said company, but this provision is not to prevent the consumer from buying elsewhere any meter approved by the water company. The water to be furnished by meters shall be read quarterly, and the rates to be charged for water, under the meter rate shall be in accordance with the annexed schedule: and a minimum rate of (Five \$5.00) Dollars per year may be established for the house of one to three rooms.
