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Ordinance No. 8.

On ordinance, granting to the Patterson Heights Water Company its lessee, successors, and assigns the assent, of the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, to erect a system of water works in said Borough, subject to certain conditions.

Be it enacted and ordained, by the Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section I. That the Patterson Heights Water Company, a corporation of the State of Pennsylvania, its lessee, successors and assigns, shall have the right and authority, by themselves, their contractors, agents, and employees, to go into and enter upon any and all of the streets, alleys, and highways within the limits of said Borough and from time to time make all necessary excavations, and

lay down and maintain all pipes and mains which may be deemed by said company, its lessees, successors and assigns necessary for the purpose of supplying water to consumers, subject, however, to the provisions hereinafter named.

Section III. The construction and laying of said pipes and mains shall be under the supervision of the Street Committee of Town Council; no opening shall be made in any street or highway, for the purpose of laying any pipe or main, without the written consent of the Street Committee first having been obtained. And in the building of the said system of pipes and mains, or any extension thereof, the use of said streets, alleys, and highways shall be impaired as little as possible, and shall be subject to such regulations as the Town Council may adopt relative to grades, or for the protection and convenience of public travel over the same.

Section ^{III} The President and Secretary of the Town Council, and the Board of the Borough of Patterson Heights are hereby authorized to execute, under the Corporate Seal of the Borough, a contract with The Patterson Heights Water Company, its issues, successors and assigns, wherein it shall be agreed that said water company shall furnish and connect with its lines in which water shall be supplied at such pressure as may be had from the tanks or reservoir now connected with the lines laid and used within said Borough, five fire hydrants, and as many more as the said Town Council may desire, of modern and improved type. At such places as may be designated by the Town Council, and from which hydrants the Borough may take and use water for the purpose of extinguishing fires.

Provided, however, that at no time said company shall be

required to construct - any main
 or line, - or extension thereof, un-
 less - assumed an - annual - income
 therefrom equal to at least
 six per centum of - the cost of con-
 struction. And in consider-
 ation of said company furnish-
 ing such hydrants, the said
 borough shall pay for the same,
 at the rate of Forty-five dollars⁴
 per annum for each of said hy-
 drants, payable quarterly on the
 first days of January, April, July
 and October of each year, during
 a period of ten (10) years from
 the date of such contract.

Section 4. It is also agreed
 by the Water Company that it will
 as often as once a month, have
 a careful inspection of all fire
 hydrants used by the party of the
 second part, and promptly re-
 pair the same when necessary;
 and that if through accident
 or otherwise, any of such hydrants
 shall remain out of order, or the
 party of the first part shall fail

at any time to provide a supply of water. The compensation payable by the Borough shall be reduced, respect being had to the number of fire-hydrants out of order, and to the length of time any such failure shall continue.

Section V: That the said water company shall not charge the inhabitants of said Borough for the use of water in excess of the following rates:

Each one to 3 roomed house - per year	\$6.00
Each 4 to 6 roomed house - per year	8.00
Each room over six rooms in each house	.75
For double house, or two families in one house, (double rates.)	
Bath Tubs, private, hot and cold water, each	4.50
Flush tank water closet	3.50
Hose for lawn, garden, and street sprinkling connection, for every fifty feet frontage, or under, and proportionately for each additional foot front, provided that ordinary garden hose connection is used	3.00
Urinal - private	3.00
Stable, private, One horse, one cow, and washing carriage	4.00
For each additional horse or cow	1.00

Section VI: And it is to be agreed that instead of a domestic or special rate herein above mentioned, consumers of water may use meters upon the following terms, to wit: The consumer may at his option, put in at his own expense an approved pattern of water meter, one of correct measurement, and where consumers exercise an option to use meters. The said company shall furnish them upon request, and upon the payment of the cost thereof to the said company, but this provision is not to prevent the consumer from buying elsewhere any meter approved by the water company. The water to be furnished by meters shall be read quarterly, and the rates to be charged for water, under the meter rate shall be in accordance with the annexed schedule: and a minimum rate of (Five \$5.00) Dollars per year may be established for the house of one to three rooms.

It is expressly understood and agreed that The Borough of Patterson Heights, - granting to the Patterson Heights Water Company, its lessees, successors and assigns, the right to erect a water system in and over and under the same herewith, reserves to itself the right, - or to grant the right to another corporation, to erect a water system to supply the said Borough or its inhabitants, with water, upon the termination of the contract to be entered into by the Borough and the water Company in accordance with this ordinance as aforesaid.

Section VIII. That the said Patterson Heights Water Company, its lessees, successors and assigns, shall pay all costs incidental to the preparation and publishing of this ordinance.

Section IX. That the said Patterson Heights Water Company, its lessees, successors and assigns, shall within thirty days after the approval

of this ordinance by the Burgess,
file with the Secretary of the
Town Council, its acceptance of
all the provisions and requirements
thereof, otherwise it shall be null
and void, and of no effect.
