

Ordinance No. 15

Ordinance granting permission to the Beaver Valley Electric Light and Power Co. the right to construct, operate and maintain lines of wires for electric light and power over and along the streets, alleys and lanes of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

Section One: Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgesses and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same that permission is hereby granted the Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co., a corporation, its successors or assigns, to construct, operate and maintain its lines of electric wires over and along the streets, lanes and alleys of the said Borough upon the terms and conditions herein stated.

Section Two: All poles shall be located and erected under the supervision and direction of the Street Committee of said Borough and all streets, lanes and alleys that may be disturbed or damaged by or under construction or maintenance of said lines shall be promptly repaired by the said company at its own expense. Said poles shall be securely planted, shall be reasonably straight, neatly shaven

and painted such colors as Council may select. The lower arm on said poles shall be at a height of not less than twenty-five feet above the present or future graded streets.

Section Three: The said Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co; its successors or assigns shall at all times save the Borough of Patterson Heights free and harmless from any and all claims for damages and otherwise growing out of erection, operation or maintenance of the said electric light and power lines, and shall respond to said Borough in damages in any amount that may be sustained by reason of negligence or imperfect work.

Section Four: In consideration of the rights herein granted, the said Company shall furnish free of cost to said Borough space on all poles erected under the provisions of this ordinance for all such fire alarm or police telegraph wires, as the said Borough may now or hereafter desire to use. All such wires to be located by said Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co, and constructed under their supervision.

Section Five: The authorities of said Borough shall have the right to change the location of any pole or poles within the said Borough. Said pole or poles shall be placed in said changed location upon fifteen days written notice from the Borough Council delivered at the

of fire of the Company and, if such company after receiving said notice fails to move said pole or poles to said new location at the expiration of said time, the said Council shall have the right to move or cause the same to be moved to such new location at the cost and expense of said Company.

Section Six: All rights herein granted are expressly granted subject to all ordinances or regulations now in force, or that may hereafter be passed by Council relative to the construction, maintenance and supervision of electric light and power lines, telegraph and telephone lines, or relative to the streets, alleys and lanes, highways of said Borough.

Section Seven: This ordinance shall be in force and effect for the period of fifty years from and after its passage, publication and acceptance in writing by said Company and no longer. Said acceptance must take place within thirty days from the date of passage hereof, or this ordinance shall be void.

Section Eight: The Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co., its successors or assigns shall furnish electric light or power, or either to every person or consumer at any location within one thousand feet of the then nearest existing line in said Borough.

Section Nine: The Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co., shall pay the cost of preparing and publishing this ordinance.

Section Ten: The Beaver Valley Electric Light & Power Co, further agrees to remove or replace all and any poles, lines and wires owned or controlled by it already existing or located within the limits of the said Borough of Patterson Heights to such reasonable location or locations as the Borough Council may determine, and in all and every other particular to make said wires, lines, and poles already constructed, as aforesaid to conform to all the other provisions of this ordinance.

Enacted into an ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights this 13th day of August, 1908.
