

Ordinance No. 17.

Ordinance forbidding the discharging of projectiles by gum slings or similar devices and the shooting of air-guns, flobert rifles and other fire arms in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County and State of Pennsylvania, and providing a penalty for violating the same.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same.

Section One: From and after the signing of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sling or project any stone, pebble or any other solid substance by means of a gum-sling, or any similar device within the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

Section Two: It shall be unlawful also after said signing of this ordinance for any person to discharge any air-gun, flobert rifle or revolver or any other firearm within the limits of the said Borough.

Section Two: It shall be unlawful also after said signing of this ordinance for any person to discharge any air-gun, flourent rifle or revolver or any other firearm within the limits of the said Borough.

Section Three: It shall be the duty of the Constable of said Borough to enforce the provisions of this ordinance. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined by the Burgess in a sum not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each and every such offense and in default of payment thereof, the Burgess may commit such offender or offenders to the County jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
