

Ordinance No. 1,8.

(An ordinance establishing the grade of Harrow Avenue from Third Avenue to First Avenue, in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Pa.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna., and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that the grade of Harrow Avenue, from the north curb of Third Avenue to the south curb of First Avenue, be and the same is hereby established as follows, to-wit:--

East Curb Grade:-- Beginning at the north curb of Third Avenue at an elevation of One thousand and forty three (1043.0) feet; thence ascending for a distance of Three hundred and twelve feet (312.0), to the south curb of Central Alley at an elevation of One thousand and forty seven and eight tenths (1047.8) feet; thence, level for a distance of Twelve feet, to the north curb of said Central Alley; thence, descending for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and forty five (1045.0) feet; thence ascending for a distance of

* thence level for a distance of thirty (30.0) feet to the north curb of said Central Avenue: thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and ten (110.0) feet, to an elevation One Thousand and forty-five and five tenths (1045.5) feet

Two hundred and six (206.0) feet, to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty three and three tenths (1053.3) feet: thence, ascending for a distance of Eighteen (18.0) feet, to the north curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty three and seven tenths (1053.7) feet: thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and eighty four (184.0) feet, to the south curb of Second Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and sixty three and fifty three hundredths (1063.53) feet: thence, level for a distance of Twenty four (24.0)

feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue: thence ascending for a distance of Two hundred (200.0) feet, to an elevation of One thousand and sixty nine (1069.0) feet: thence, descending for a distance of Two hundred and eighteen (218.0) feet, to the south curb of First Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty three and six tenths (1053.6) feet.

West Curb Grade:--

Beginning at the north curb of Third Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and forty three and six tenths (1043.6) feet; thence, ascending for a distance of Three hundred and twelve (312.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Alley, at an elevation of One Thousand and forty eight (1048.0) feet; thence, level for a distance of Twelve (12.0) feet, to the north curb of said Central Alley; thence, descending for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and forty five and five tenths (1045.5) feet; thence, level for a distance of Thirty (30.0) feet, to the north curb of said Central Avenue; thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and ten (110.0) feet, to an elevation of One thousand and forty six (1046.0) feet; thence ascending for a distance of Two hundred and six (206.0) feet, to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty three and six tenths (1053.6) feet; thence, ascending

for a distance of Eighteen (18.0) feet, to the north curb of said Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty four (1054.0) feet: thence ascending for a distance of One hundred and eighty four (184.0) feet, to the south curb of Second Avenue, at an elevation of

One thousand and sixty three and sixty three hundredths (1063.63) feet: thence, level for a distance of Twenty four (24.0) feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue: thence ascending for a distance of Two hundred (200.0) feet, to an elevation of One thousand and sixty nine (1069.0) feet: thence, descending for a distance of Two hundred eighteen (218.0) feet, to the south curb of First Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and fifty three and four tenths (1053.4) feet:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this enactment, ^{be and of the name} are hereby repealed.

And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the book known as the Borough Grade Book.

Enacted into a law by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna., this 14th. day of September, 1911.
