

Ordinance #36

An Ordinance prohibiting the firing of any cannon, mortar, arvil or any other iron or metal instrument for the purpose of making any loud or unseemly noise or noises by exploding therein gun powder or any other explosive chemical or substance within the Borough of Patterson Heights.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to set off or fire any cannon, mortar arvil or other metal instrument by exploding therein gun-powder or any other explosive chemical or substance for the purpose of making any loud or unseemly noise or noises within the limits of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County Pennsylvania.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of disorderly conduct, and for each and every such offence shall be fined not more than ten (\$10⁰⁰) dollars, and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned not more than ten days in the County Jail and it shall be the duty of the Town Constable of said Borough to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.
