

## Ordinance #45

(Establishing a grade on Hillside Avenue in the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania from the south curb of Central Avenue to the Borough Line dividing and separating said Borough from the City of Beaver Falls).

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same that the grade of Hillside Avenue, from the south curb of Central Avenue to the Borough Line dividing and separating said Borough from the City of Beaver Falls, be and is hereby established as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the south curb of Central Avenue at an elevation of one thousand twenty six ( $1026.0^{\circ}$ ) feet thence descending for a distance of one thousand ( $1000.0^{\circ}$ ) feet to an elevation of Nine Hundred Thirty Seven and four-tenths ( $937.4^{\circ}$ ) feet; thence descending for a distance of Three Hundred Fifty ( $350.0^{\circ}$ ) feet to an elevation of Nine Hundred four ( $904.0^{\circ}$ ) feet; thence descending for a distance of four hundred ( $400.0^{\circ}$ ) feet to an elevation of Eight Hundred Seventy Two and two-tenths ( $872.2^{\circ}$ ) feet thence descending for a distance of about Six Hundred Fifty ( $650.0^{\circ}$ ) feet to the Borough Line at an elevation of Eight Hundred Fourteen ( $814.0^{\circ}$ ) feet.

And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the book known as the Borough Grade book. Enacted into an ordinance the 11th. day of December, 1913.
