

## Ordinance # 58

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the President and the Secretary of the Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, for and on behalf of the Borough of Patterson Heights, of the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to make and enter into a contract with the Beaver County Light Company, of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid, to furnish electric lighting for the streets and highways of the Borough of Patterson Heights.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted the Burgess and the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, of the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that the President of Council and the Secretary of Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights be and they are hereby authorized and directed forthwith, in the name and on behalf of the Borough of Patterson Heights, of the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to make and enter into a contract with the Beaver County Light Company for electric lighting of the streets and highways of the said Borough, said contract to be as follows:

# Articles of Agreement

Made and executed this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_  
A. D., 1920 by and between the Borough of  
Patterson Heights, of the County of Beaver, Com-  
monwealth of Pennsylvania, party of the first  
part, hereinafter termed the Borough, and the  
Beaver County Light Company, of the County and  
Commonwealth aforesaid, party of the second  
part, hereinafter termed the Light Company

WHEREAS: The Light Company has been  
supplying electric lighting for the streets  
and highways of the Borough under a con-  
tract terminating October 1st, 1918, and

WHEREAS: It is our desire of the Borough  
to continue such electric lighting of the street  
and highways:

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH

FIRST: The Light Company hereby stipulates  
and agrees to furnish unto the Borough and  
the Borough hereby agrees to take from the Light  
Company and to pay the Light Company therefor  
for and during the term of five (5) years from  
June 3rd, 1920 of date of connection under  
this contract electric light from

Thirty

(30) Tungsten Series Street Lamp of  
One hundred (100) Candle Power Rating each  
at the rate of Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars  
per lamp per annum;

None (No) Tungsten Series Street Lamps of Two hundred ~~and~~ fifty (250) Candle Power Rating each at the rate of forty (\$40.00) dollars per lamp per annum;

None (No) Tungsten Series Street Lamps of Four hundred (400) Candle Power Rating each at the rate of Fifty five (\$55.00) dollars per lamp per annum;

and electric light from such additional lamps of the type or types hereinbefore specified as the Borough may subsequently elect to have installed and use during the remaining unexpired portion of the term of this contract the cost of installation to be borne by the Light Company. The aforesaid service shall be supplied to the Borough and the Borough shall pay therefor, as provided in Schedule "Standard Municipal Series Street Lighting Service," of the published Schedule of Rates (P. S. Co Pa. No. 4) of the Light Company, and it is hereby agreed that the aforesaid Schedule "T" shall be read into and made a part of this agreement.

SECOND; The aforesaid lamps are to be used for lighting the streets and highways of the Borough, and together with all connections and other appurtenances furnished by the Light Company shall be and remain the property of the Light Company and may be removed by the Light Company upon the termination of this Agreement.

THIRD: All lamps shall be furnished and set on standard wooden poles and shall be supplied with electric current from overhead lines and shall be maintained by the Light Company and kept burning from

dusk until dawn each and every night. Should any or all lamps fail to burn during the time for lighting and extinguishing said lamps each night for a continuous period of one or more hours, the Light Company shall deduct from the bill rendered to the Borough a sum calculated at a proportionate rate as provided for service under this Agreement for such time as said lamp or lamps may be out of service.

FOURTH: The Light Company may charge for line extensions when the distance is greater than 500 feet from the terminus of the Light Company's street lighting lines to the lamps to be installed.

FIFTH: It is understood and agreed that all covenants, stipulations and agreements herein contained shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective parties hereto, and their successors and assigns, respectively.

In witness whereof the President of Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, duly authorized, has set his hand and affixed the corporate seal of the aforesaid Borough of Patterson Heights, duly attested by the Borough Secretary, and the Beaver County Light Company has hereto set its corporate seal, duly attested by its President or Vice President and Secretary or Assistant Secretary the day and year aforesaid.

400 Candle Power Tungsten Series Street Lamps  
\$25.00 per lamp per annum

600 Candle Power Tungsten Series Street Lamps  
\$65.00 per lamp per annum.

TERM —

Contracts shall be written for a term  
of not less than three (3) years.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS —

Service will be supplied from overhead  
distribution lines, and the Light Company reserves  
the right to charge for line extensions where  
the distance is greater than 500 feet from  
the terminus of the Light Company's supply  
lines to the lamp to be installed.

Payments for service supplied under this Rate shall be made in proportionate monthly installments on or before the fifteenth day of each succeeding month. The lamps shall be lighted nightly from dusk till dawn.

SECTION: All Ordinances or part of Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as the same effect this Ordinance
