

Ordinance # 74.

An Ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, changing the names of certain streets and avenues in said Borough.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, at it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows.

Section I: — That from and after the passage and promulgation of this Ordinance, the names of the following streets and avenues shall be changed as follows.

First Avenue to Fourth Street.

Second Avenue to Fifth Street.

Spring Street to Sixth Street.

Central Avenue to Seventh Street.

Third Avenue to Eighth Street.

Myrtle Avenue to Fourth Avenue.

Elm Avenue to Fifth Avenue.

Iron Avenue to Sixth Avenue.

Frank Avenue to Seventh Avenue.

Barber Avenue to Eighth Avenue.

Stattie and Short Street to Ninth Avenue.

Section II — All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed insofar as the same are in conflict with this ordinance.
