

## Ordinance # 79.

An Ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, recognizing "The Patterson Heights Firemen's Relief Association" as the proper body to receive the tax upon premiums from foreign fire insurance companies.

Be It Enacted and Ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Section I - That the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby recognizes and designates "The Patterson Heights Firemen's Relief Association" as the proper body or organization to receive the tax upon premiums from foreign fire insurance companies as and when the same is paid over to the borough by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section II.- The proper officers of the said Borough are hereby required to pay over to the Patterson Heights Firemen's Relief Association all such monies as are received by the Borough as a tax upon premiums from foreign fire insurance companies.

Section III- All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
