ORDINANCE No. 87.

AN ORDINANCE of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, prohibiting the lighting of garbage incinerators within the Borough limits between the hours ten o'clock A.M. and twelve o'clock P.M.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to light garbage incinerators between the hours ten o'clock A.M. and twelve o'clock P.M.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for each offence to be recovered by information made before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace. In default of payment the offender shall be confined to the Borough lock-up or the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.
