


AN ORDINANCE of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, prohibiting certain trucks and trailers on Hillside Avenue and limiting the weight of trucks on other streets of said Borough.


BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. That no motor vehicle of any kind whatsoever (loaded or empty) weighing more than six (6) tons shall be operated on any part of Hillside Avenue and that no truck and trailer shall together be operated on said Hillside Avenue of any weight whatsoever.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation being convicted of the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace shall be liable to a fine of \$10.00 for each separate offense, and in default thereof to imprisonment in the Borough Lock-up or County Jail for a period of not more than one day for each dollar of fine.
